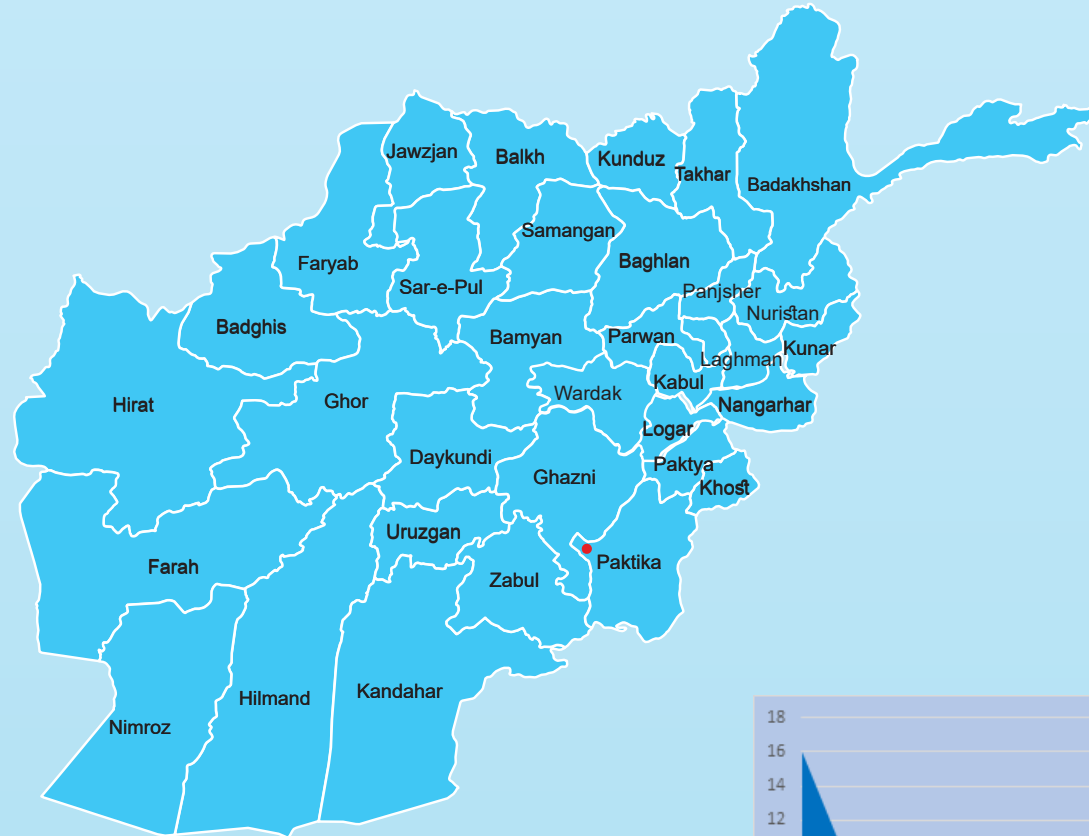

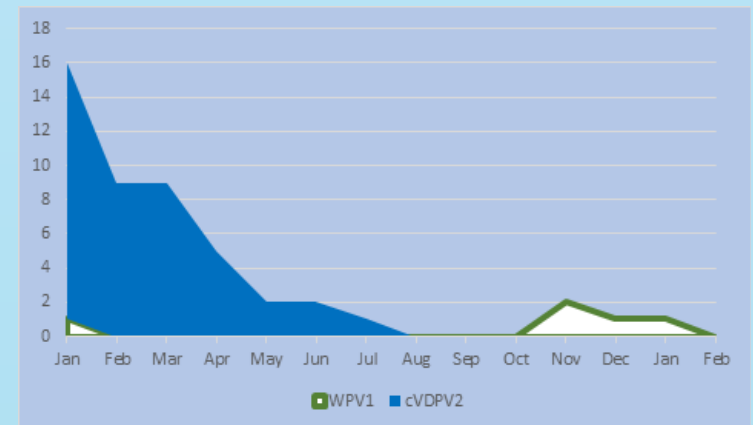

POLIO TRANSMISSION

- No Wild Poliovirus (WPV1) case was confirmed in February 2022



AFP / ENVIRONMENTAL SURVEILLANCE

- 361 children with Acute Flaccid Paralysis (AFP) - 170 females and 190 males - were reported in February 2022. A total of 762 AFP cases have been reported since the beginning of 2022. Of these, 518 cases have been discarded as non-polio. About 243 cases are pending final classification
- The non-polio AFP rate is 17, stool adequacy stood above 93%, and non-polio enterovirus rate was 19% in all regions
- No new WPV1 and no new cVDPV2 positive environmental samples were confirmed in November 2021



SUPPLEMENTARY VACCINATION ACTIVITIES

- 6,755,817 children were vaccinated against polio during the February NIDs.



COMPLEMENTARY VACCINATION ACTIVITIES

- 12 cross-border vaccination points, 45 cross-border teams and 458 permanent transit teams (PTTs) were operational in February 2022.
- Permanent transit teams vaccinated 846,027 children, and cross-border teams vaccinated 100,038 children against polio in February 2022
- 761 children under 10 were given OPV in UNHCR repatriation centre and IOM sites receiving returnees and refugees from Pakistan and Iran in February 2022.
- From January 1st 2022 to date, 874 returnee children were vaccinated with OPV.
- 411 international travelers were vaccinated in February 2022 in compliance with IHR.



Key communication activities

- 23,293 caregivers were engaged on issues related to polio, routine immunization, maternal and child health promotion, and COVID-19 preventative measures in south, west, and northeast regions
- 387,041 children under five were given polio vaccine drops, 29,794 children under two were vaccinated for routine immunization and 15,064 women and girls received Tetanus vaccine across the target health facilities
- 674,460 females were reached with polio and mother and child health awareness messages by the female mobilizers/vaccinators (FMVs) through 58,688 face-to-face sessions in the east, west, and south regions
- 3,431 individuals, including religious influencers, local authorities and community influencers were reached with awareness in the south, west, and north-east regions
- 293,800 soap bars were distributed to target health centres in the south, east, and west regions
- 2,946 elderly women engaged in consultations for improving women's role in polio immunization drives and COVID-19 prevention in the South region.
