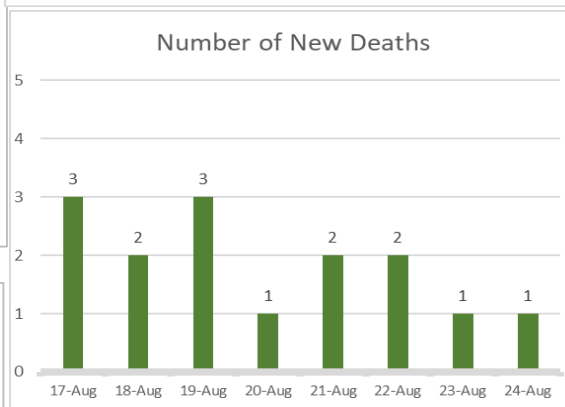
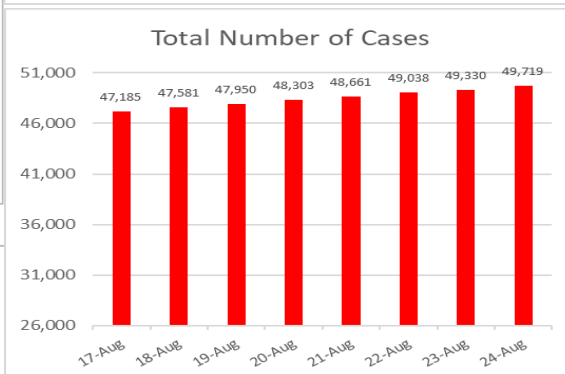
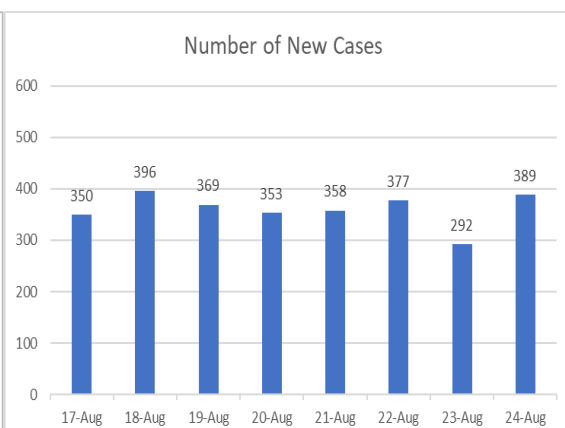

HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortality was a 71 years old male Bahraini Citizen.
- The Vice President of Medical Services in Primary Care stressed the importance of all members of Bahraini society continuing to adhere to the precautionary and preventive measures limit the spread of Corona virus, including avoidance of gatherings.
- The Ministry of Health continues random screening campaigns in various regions of Bahrain.
- Undersecretary of the Ministry of Health confirmed that the good efforts of the Bahrain medical team in limiting the spread of COVID-19 and establishing pertinent protocols for prevention, treatment, and recovery, as well as implementing protocols for examination and dealing with travelers.
- Ministry of Health made a video containing volunteers' statements during the third clinical trials of the Corona vaccine.
- Nearly 2,300 random tests are performed daily for the coronavirus infection (COVID19) by mobile units.
- The Ministerial Cabinet approved yesterday new policies for flexi work permits, licensing and commercial registration, emphasizing the importance of abiding by rules.
