HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortality were: a 40, 67 and 83 years old male Bahraini Citizen.
- HRH the Crown Prince expressed thanks to the 6000 volunteers participating in Phase III Clinical Trials of COVID-19 vaccine for meeting the Kingdom's target.
- Ministry of Health announced the end of Coronavirus vaccine volunteering, as the 6,000-target count was reached within six weeks.
- Under the patronage of HRH the Prime Minister "Bahrain Visions Forum on Shared Visions for a Successful Future" will be organized by the Prime Minister's Court (on 29 September 2020) in cooperation with the World Health Organization (WHO), discussing SDGs in post-pandemic time.
- H.E Minister of Foreign Affairs participated virtually in the High-Level Opening Session of the UNGA 75th Session.
- MOH Assistant Undersecretary for Primary Care emphasized that social responsibility requires everyone to urge relatives to adhere to all precautionary measures during the next two weeks.
- National Taskforce for Combating the Coronavirus will hold a press conference today to highlight the latest COVID-19 developments in Bahrain.
- Five MPs presented an urgent proposal to forgive all outstanding personal loans taken out by Bahrainis.

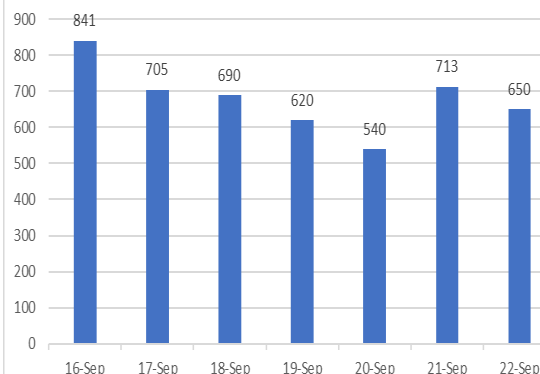

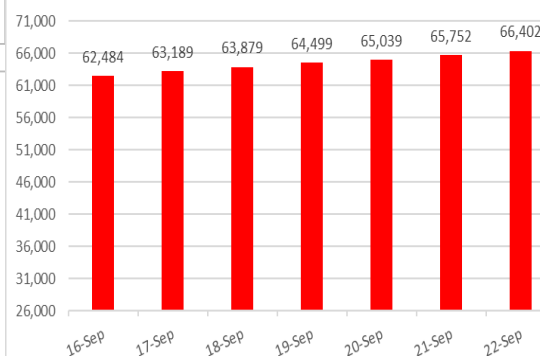
