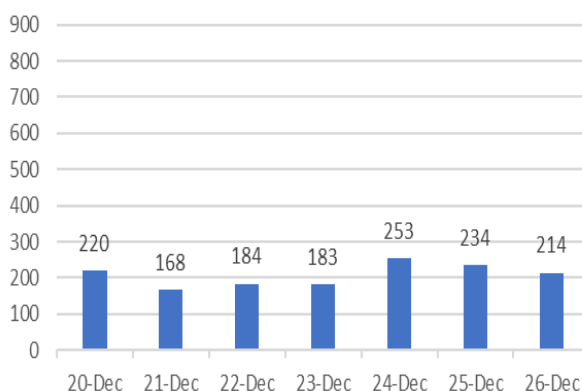

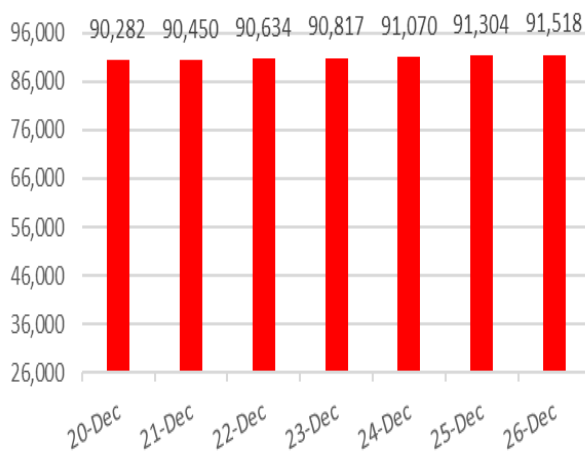
## HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortality was a 85 year old male Bahraini Citizens.
- Increasing numbers of citizens and residents across Bahrain continue to take the COVID-19 vaccine, as part of the National Vaccination Campaign.
- Ministry of Health revealed that total number of individuals vaccinated as of December 2020 reached 51,556.
- No health complications have been reported amongst thousands of volunteers who took the COVID-19 vaccine during the clinical trials in Bahrain.
- Supreme Council for Women (SCW) highlighted that Bahraini women have been playing a crucial role in confronting the coronavirus pandemic through their commitment.
- Ministry of Health identified thirteen positive COVID-19 cases across four accommodations after an expatriate worker developed symptoms.
- Ministry of Health suspends vaccination walk-in-service at health centers, urging citizens and residents to register online for COVID-19 vaccination appointments.
