Situation Report No. 23 - Kingdom of Bahrain



Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 6 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 47,700 tests were conducted.
- At present there are 294 active cases still receiving treatment, 4 cases are in critical condition, and 458 individuals were discharged.
- No new mortalities were recorded.
- Ministry of Health continues to conduct field visits across Kingdom to enhance COVID-19 containment measures.
- Ministry of Foreign Affairs extends eservices to the public as well as for internal work procedures.
- Hotline 444 for reporting new or suspected cases.

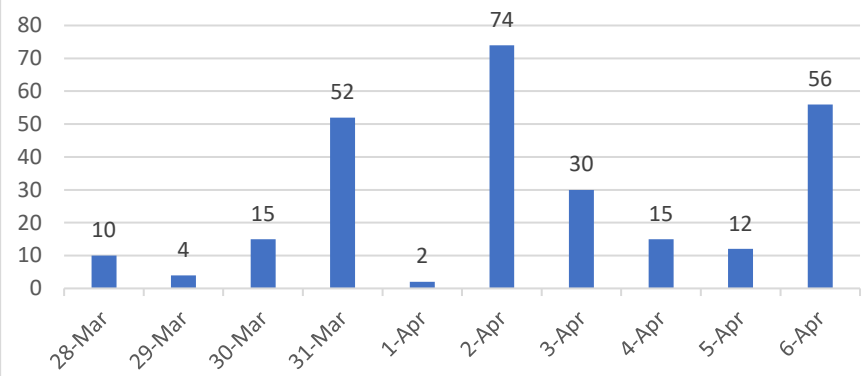
