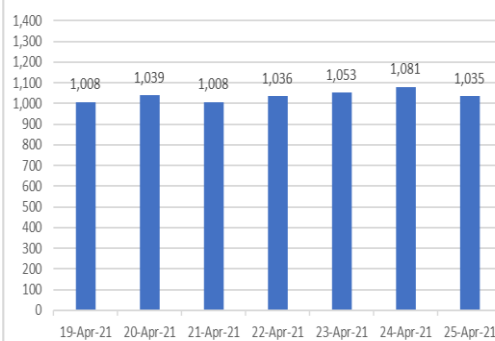

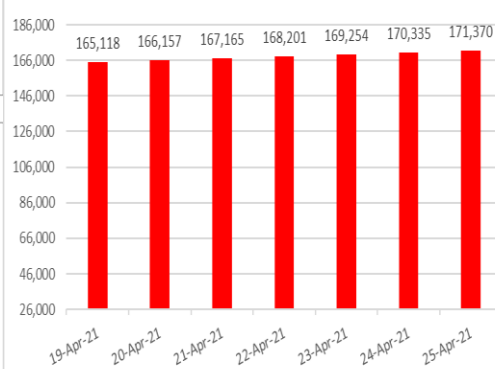
HIGHLIGHTS

- The Mortality were: 13 Bahraini citizens (8 male (52, 56, 61, 70, 74, 78, 79 and 86 years old) and 5 female (33, 62, 63, 67 and 69 years old)) and 6 expatriates (5 male (45, 47, 54, 56 and 59 years old) and 1 female (38 years old)).
- Increasing number of citizens and residents continue to take COVID-19 Vaccine in Bahrain; and Ministry of Health (MOH) revealed the total number of individuals vaccinated as of 25 April 2021 for the first dose (659,990) and for the second dose (520,745).
- National Medical Taskforce for Combating the Coronavirus updated arrival procedures for passengers from India, Pakistan, and Bangladesh (effective 27 April 2021).
- Over half a million people have received two doses of COVID-19 vaccine, marking a new milestone in Bahrain's vaccination campaign (A total of 507,861 individuals have taken two jabs as of Thursday 22 April – accounting for 36% of population).
- Interior Minister: No active COVID-19 cases are observed in Reform Facilities, while launching projects to enable inmates to earn money.
- Nearly 50 positive COVID-19 work-related cases were identified after three expatriates developed symptoms.
- Five mosques were closed for one week for further COVID-19 protocols.
- Two restaurants have been shut down for one week for violating the mandatory precautionary measures to combat COVID-19.
- Food bank is overcoming challenges posed by the coronavirus pandemic by delivering meals to families in need during.

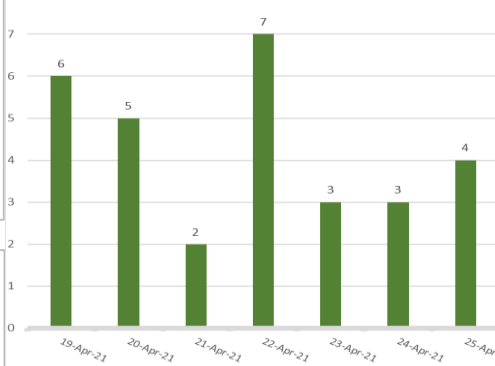
Number of New Cases
