Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 18 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 83,000 tests were conducted.
- 29 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 1773.
- At present there are 1,011 active cases still receiving treatment, 3 of them in critical condition, and 755 individuals were discharged.
- No new mortality and no community transmission recorded.
- WHO releases new guidance on safe Ramadan practices in context of COVID-19 (see link below).

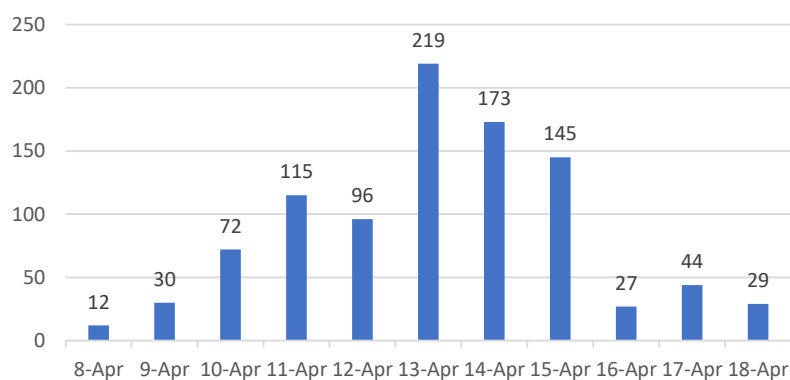
