Situation Report No. 40 - Kingdom of Bahrain

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 23 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 101,700 tests were conducted.
- 71 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 2,098.
- At present there are 1,127 active cases still receiving treatment, 1 of them in critical condition, and 1,082 individuals were discharged.
- 1 mortality recorded; no community transmission recorded.
- The Ministry of Health announces that the death was for a 36-year-old expatriate male who had underlying and chronic health conditions.
- Health Ministry announces Ramadan timings for Salmaniya Medical Complex and health centres.
- Bahrain receives a shipment of hydroxy chloroquine from India, after the approval of the Government of India to export the drug.

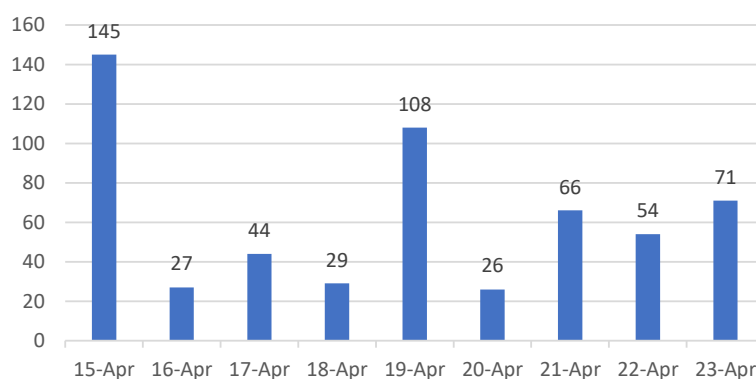
