HIGHLIGHTS

- Approximately 155,500 tests were conducted.
- 187 newly confirmed cases, bringing total to 3,720.
- At present there are 1,950 active cases still receiving treatment, 1 of them in critical condition, and 1,762 individuals were discharged.
- No mortality and no community transmission recorded.

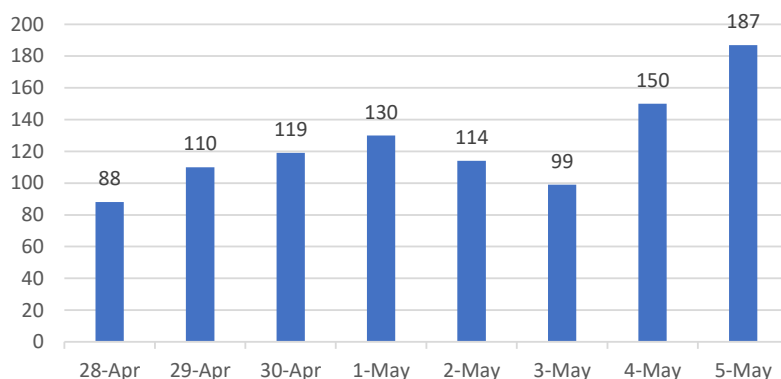
