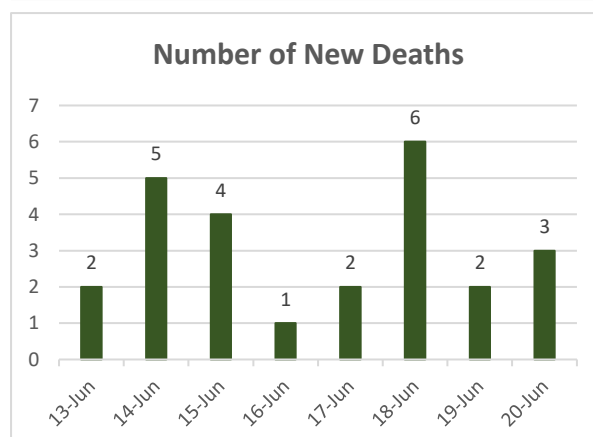
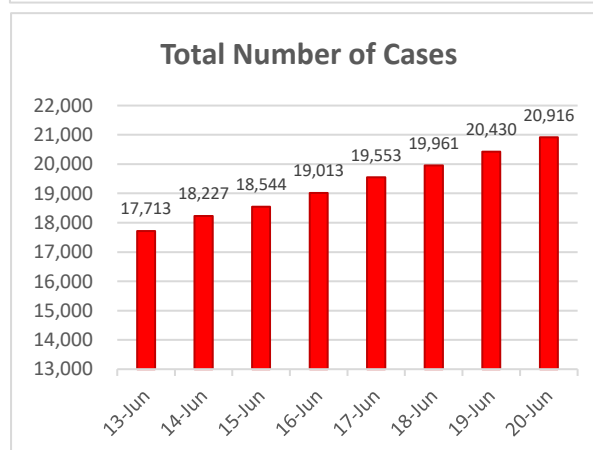
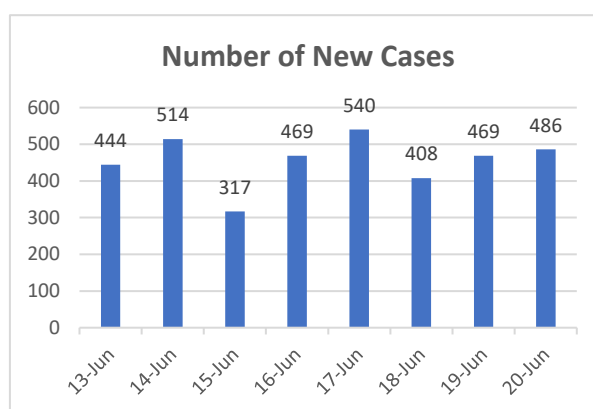

HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortalities were 8 Bahraini (46, 50, 64 years-old female and 58, 64, 67, 72 and 83 years-old male citizens) and 3 male expatriates (55, 64, and 69 years-old).
- Heads of nursing services at the Ministry of Health participate in the WHO Global Forum.
- Role of technology in Bahrain's efforts to mitigate COVID-19 spread highlighted.
- 40,000 face masks were provided by voluntary efforts in a first phase to combat (COVID-19).
- WHO updates criteria for releasing patients from isolation (see link below).
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages.
