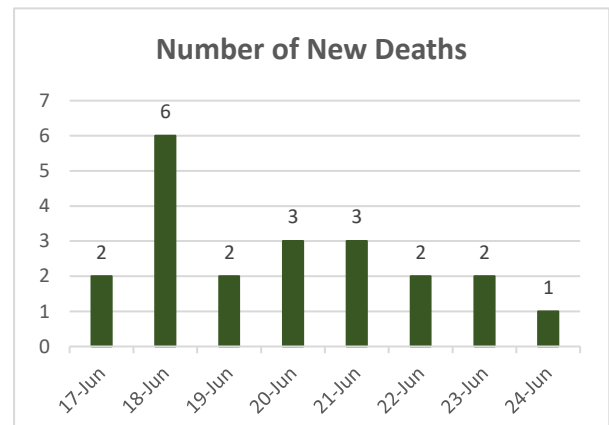
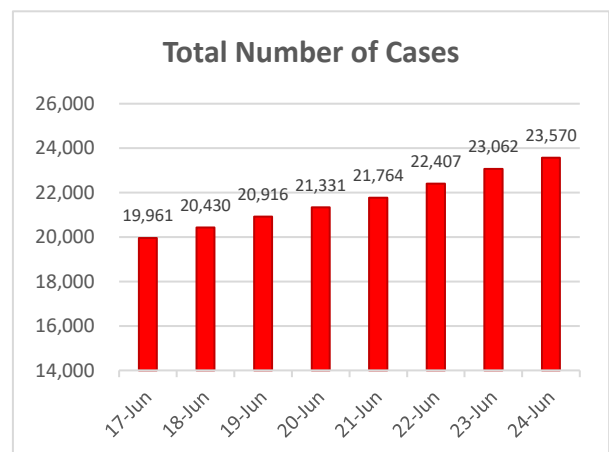
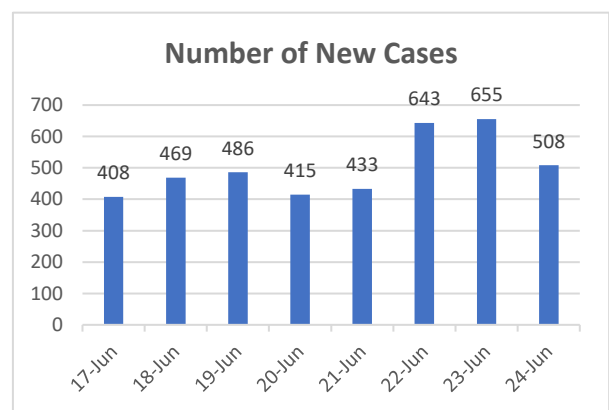

HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortality was a 75-year-old male citizen.
- The recovery rate reached 76.3% and deaths 0.29%.
- Bahrain highlights its efforts to support persons with disabilities during COVID-19 at the ESCWA meeting on 24 June.
- The National Taskforce for Combating Coronavirus has highlighted measures taken to mitigate the spread of COVID-19
