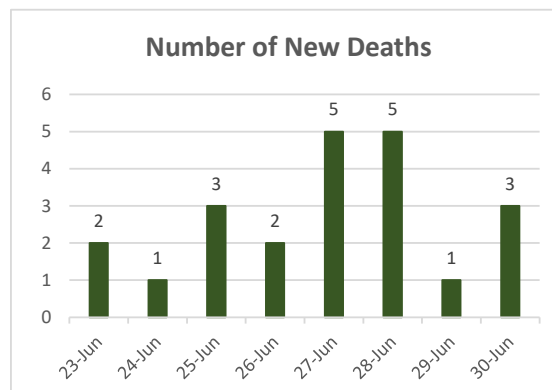
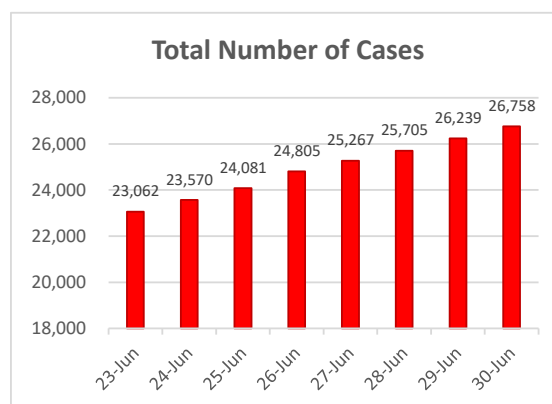
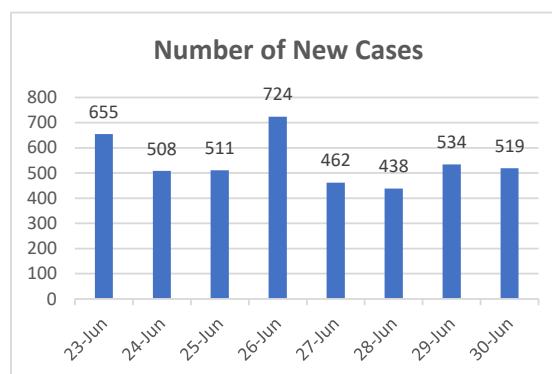

## HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortalities were: 1 female Bahraini citizen (34 years old) and 2 male expatriates (57 and 60 years old).
- MoH: 6028 medical consultations answered by video and communication technologies.
- A number of private hospitals have been granted permits to conduct optional tests for Coronavirus for people who do not have any symptoms.
- The Ministry of Industry, Commerce and Tourism completes the second phase of the medical sterilizers distribution campaign.
- WHO updates criteria for releasing patients from isolation (see link below).
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages.
