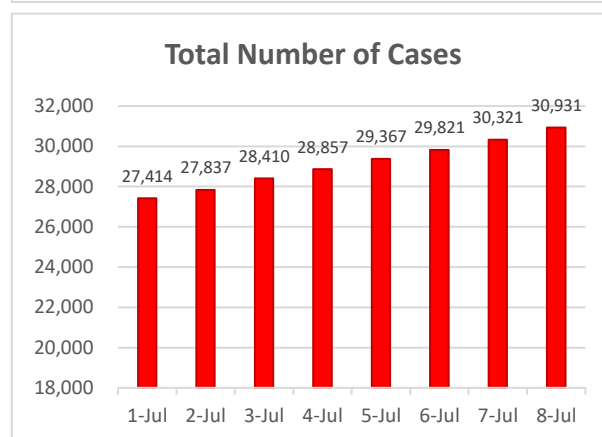
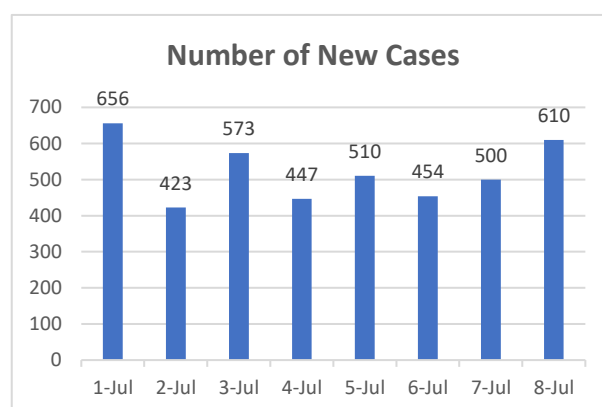

## HIGHLIGHTS

- Out of total confirmed cases: 84.3% recovery rate and 0.32% mortality rate.
- Members of Parliament have urged the government to review Commercial Registration requirements for businesses adversely impacted by the coronavirus disease.
- Solidarity trial interim results show that hydroxychloroquine and lopinavir/ritonavir produce little or no reduction in mortality of hospitalized COVID-19 patients (see link below).
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages, see link below.
