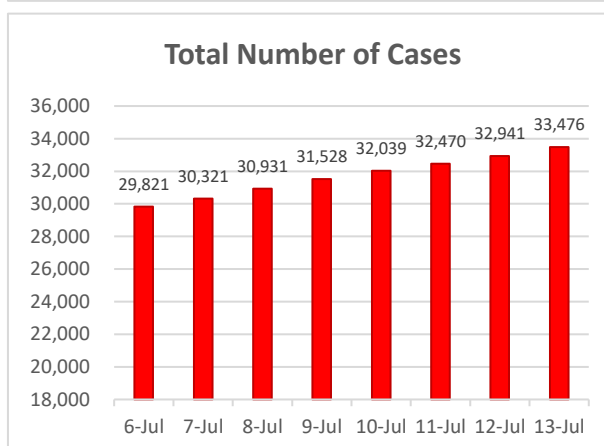
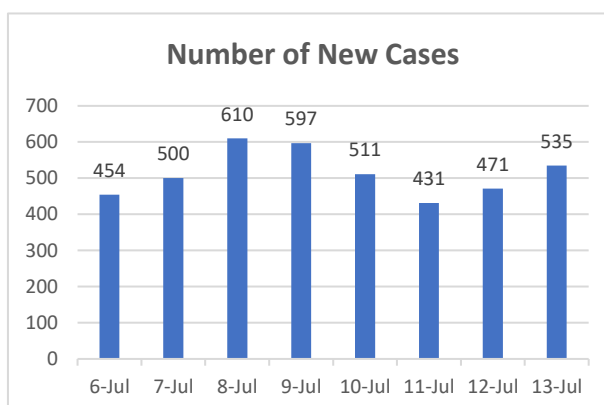

HIGHLIGHTS

- The mortality was a 57 year-old female citizen.
- King Fahad Causeway connecting Bahrain and Saudi Arabia is set to reopen next month after Eid Al Adha holiday.
- MoH launches free what's app auto reply service to send up-to-date information to the population on the spread of COVID-19.
- The Chinese National Electrical Engineering Company donated various medical supplies related to the coronavirus pandemic to the Ministry of Electricity and Water Affairs of Bahrain.
- Solidarity trial interim results show that hydroxychloroquine and lopinavir/ritonavir produce little or no reduction in mortality of hospitalized COVID-19 patients (see link below).
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages.
