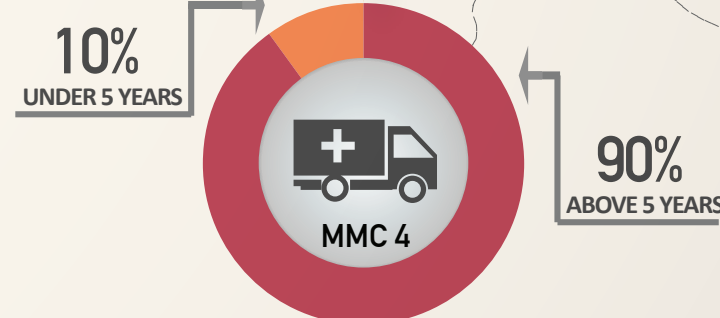

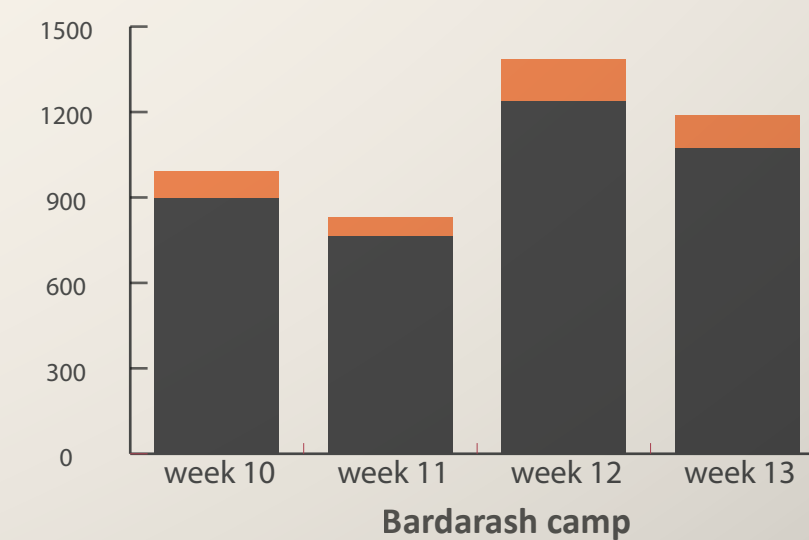

MOBILE MEDICAL CLINICS OVERVIEW

Department of Health (DoH) was provided with four Mobile Medical Clinics (MMC) on 23rd January, 2015 with the support of the Saudi Funds. All the MMCs are operational and working in four different districts (Zakho, Sumel, Shekhan, Bardarash) where high concentration of IDPs are present in Dahuk Governorate.

During March; the number of consultations recorded by these four MMC was 12,502 consultations. Out of the consultations recorded during this period, 8,115 cases (64%) were Acute Respiratory Infection (ARI), 1,470 cases (12%) were skin diseases followed by 679 cases (5%) of Acute Diarrhea. 536 cases (4%) had eye infections while 649 cases (5%) complained of hypertension and 768 cases (6%) had diabetes.

76% of the consultations made by these MMCs were above 5 years of age and 24% were under five years. Average from the consultations during this period showed that of 52% of the consultations were females and 48% were male who required medical attention through these four MMCs.

The highest number of consultations 11,573 was carried out by MMC working in the Sumel district, followed by 4,747 consultations provided by the MMC working in Esysan District. The MMC working Bardarash district provided 1,772 consultations and the lowest number of consultations of 1,076 per provided by the MMC working in Zakho district.

Neither major alerts nor outbreaks were generated or detected by the MMC working in the four districts of Zakho, Sumel, Shekhan, Bardarash.
