IRAQ: Snapshot of WHO Response Activities in Kirkuk Governorate 2016

MILESTONES OF 2016

1

MOBILE TEAMS: WHO supported 7 mobile medical teams in 4 districts in Kirkuk since April 2015 to cover IDPs and the host community in hard reach areas and provided preventive and curative primary health services

2

PHARMACEUTICALS: WHO prepositioned 3 trauma and surgical kits, in preparation for Hawija liberation.

3

MOBILE CLINIC: WHO donated 3 mobile medical clinics and 2 ambulances to ensure health services to internally displaced persons in Kirkuk

4

VECTOR CONTROL: Vector control activities, especially for Leishmaniasis, included spraying water surfaces with pesticides night fogging, rodent control, Entomological surveillance and Flies control for months of: May, June, Oct and Nov.

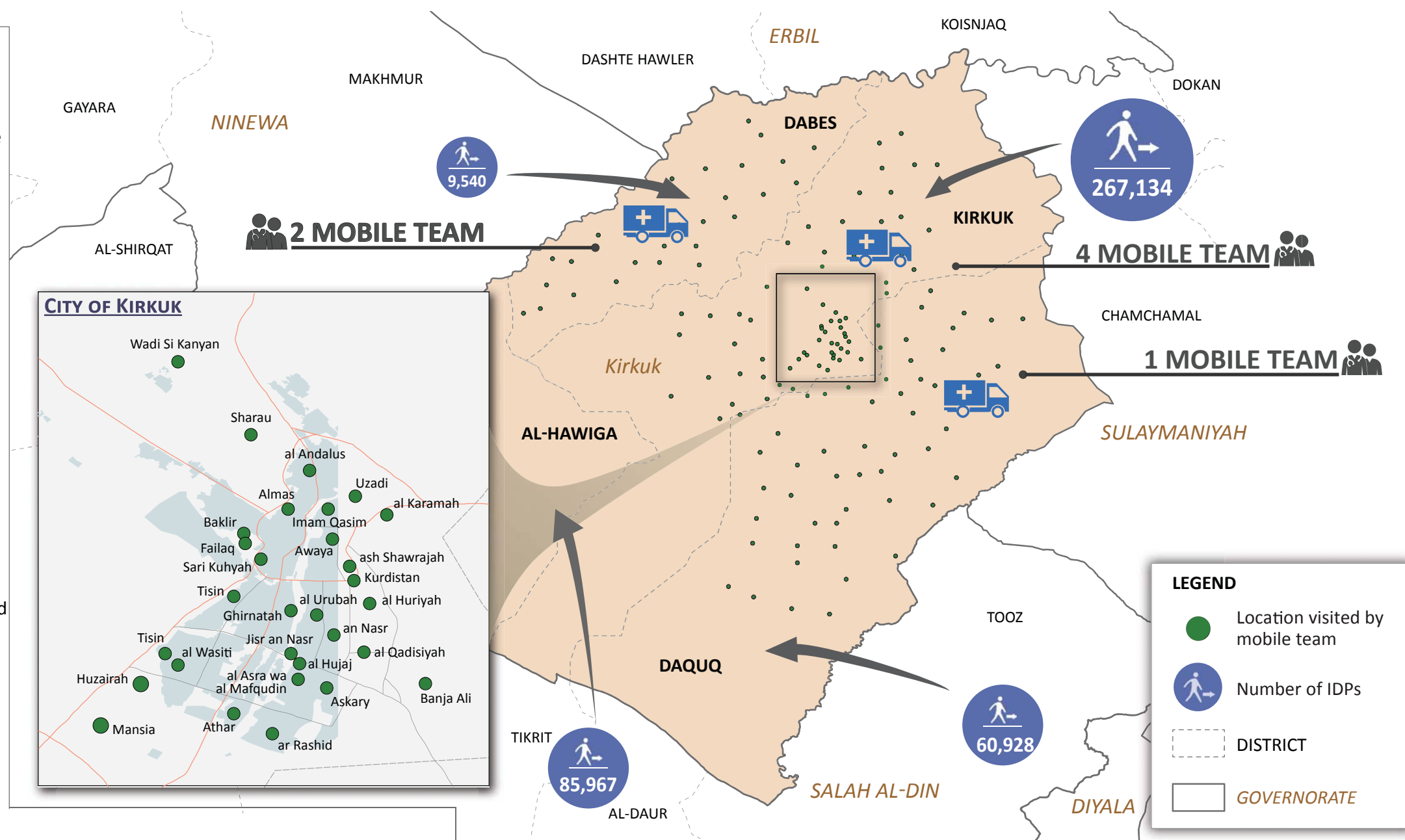
TRAINING 20 national staff have been trained on management of patients exposed to chemical weapon agents. Forty special sets of PPE's for Chemical Weapons were donated to Kirkuk DOH

6

Disease Surveillance 10 new staff, were trained on the use of electronic system EWARN. 14 reporting sites including static and mobile facilities, are reporting regularly in the EWARN system in Kirkuk.

Daquq Camp WHO donated 2 caravans (4 rooms) for the IDP camp clinic in Daquq

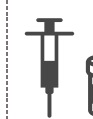
