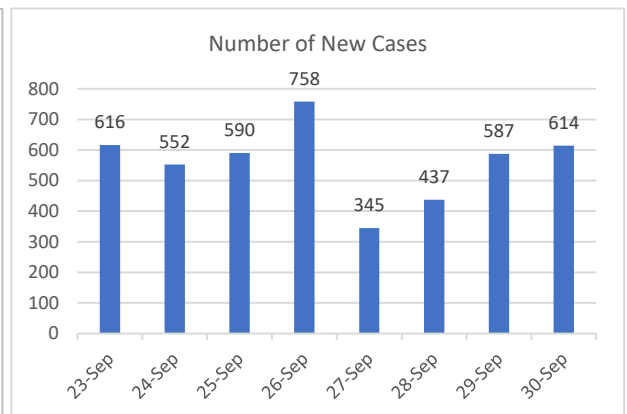

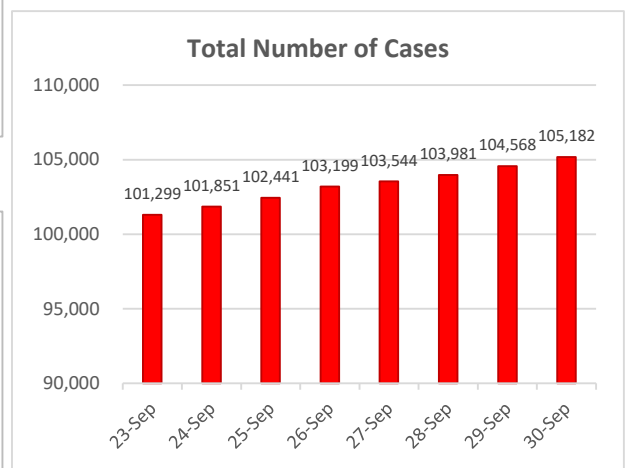
## HIGHLIGHTS

- Municipality inspectors in the Capital Governorate conducted inspections of 6,450 shops to combat COVID-19, resulting in 386 warning citations, 523 violation citations and closure of 62 shops.
- MoH: The rapid car inspection services in Sabhan area continues to operate during the official holiday with double the capacity due to the exceptional circumstances.
