

Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

Situation Report No. 18 - Kuwait



Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 2 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Total 342 confirmed cases, 53 new cases in two days.
- 260 cases remain under treatment, 15 of them are in critical condition.
- 82 cases recovered and were discharged.
- 2,466 individuals remain quarantined.
- No mortality and no community transmission has been reported so far.
- On April first, a decision was taken to close car maintenance workshops and spare parts shops.
- A resident, 60 years old, presented to the hospital with heart attack and died in the hospital, investigations showed he had symptomless COVID-19; no decision is taken yet to assign the cause of death.
- During March, 463 shops were closed across the country due to violation of COVID-19 preventive measures.

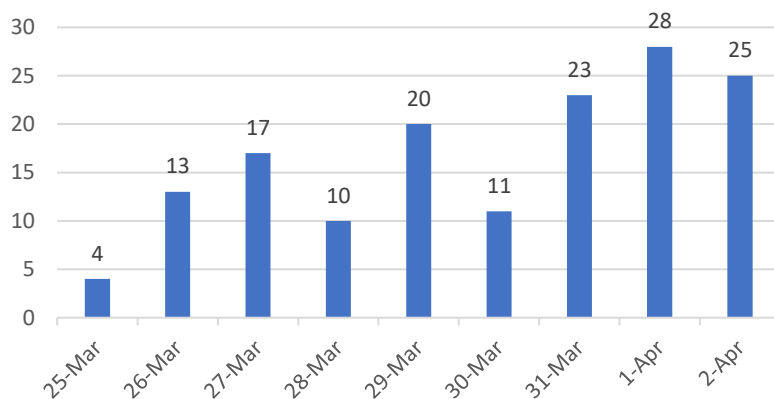
