

# Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

## Situation Report No. 22 - Kuwait



Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 6 April 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

- Total 665 confirmed cases, 109 new cases in one day.
- No new mortalities recorded.
- 559 cases remain under treatment, 20 of them are in critical condition.
- 105 cases recovered and were discharged.
- 2,474 individuals remain quarantined.
- No community transmission has been reported so far.
- Kuwait government decided to extend the partial curfew by two hours as of Monday 6 April to be between 5:00 p.m until 6:00 a.m., as well as imposing a lockdown on the area of Mahboula and Jleeb Al-Shuyoukh
- Kuwait petroleum firm completes quarantine for coronavirus
- Kuwait government extends holiday until April 23, people resume work April 26.

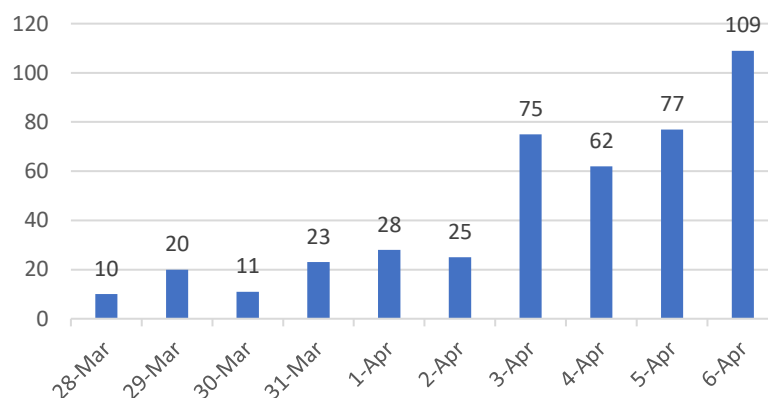
