



HIGHLIGHTS

- Of the new cases, 463 (65.9%) are nationals.
- New infections by health area :Al Ahmadi (209), Al Jahra (180), Al Farwaniyah (131), Hawally (115) and Capital Area (68).
- 29 flights to 8 countries carrying 5,285 expatriates back to their countries as part of the amnesty programme.
- Priority for return to Kuwait is given for expatriates working in specific government jobs such as the personnel working for the judiciary, doctors, teachers and the nursing staff.
- The Red Crescent backs state institutions against COVID-19.
- Solidarity trial interim results show that hydroxychloroquine and lopinavir/ritonavir produce little or no reduction in mortality of hospitalized COVID-19 patients (see link below).
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages (see link below).
