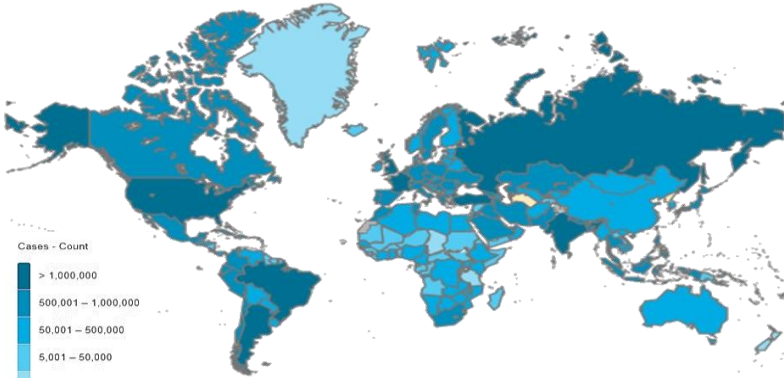




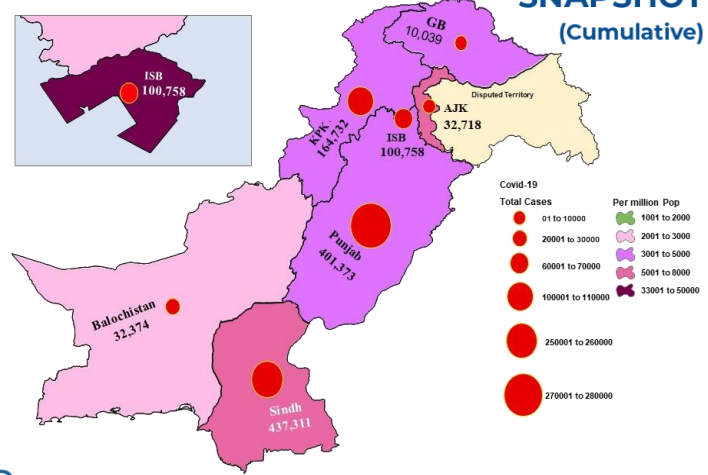

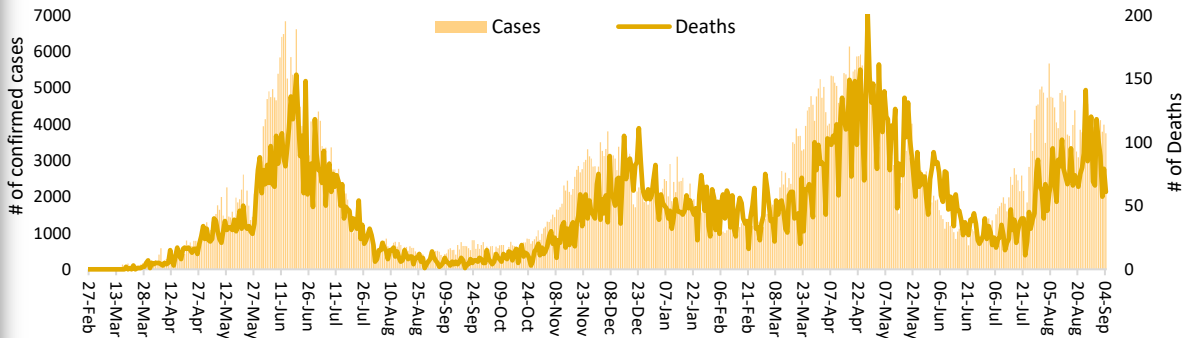

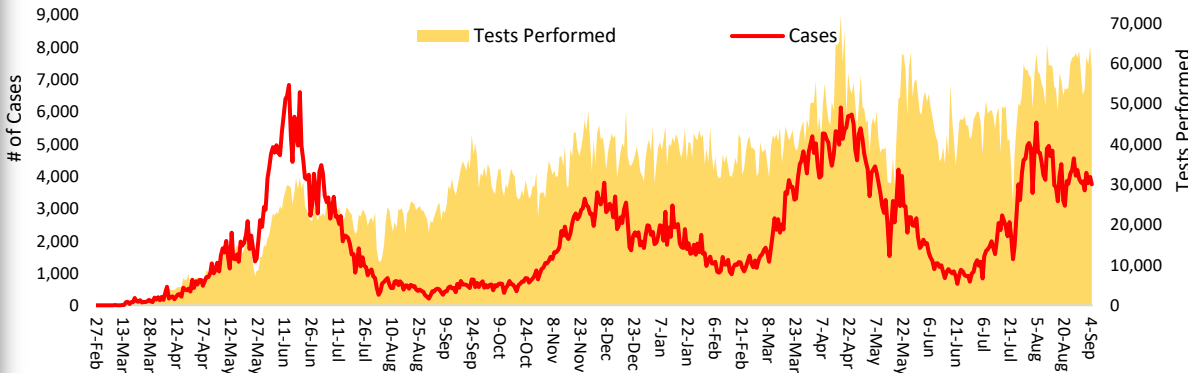

On 2<sup>nd</sup> September 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala paid a visit to Khyber Medical University (KMU), Peshawar. The WR was received by the vice chancellor, KMU Prof. Dr Zia-ul-Haq. The two officials discussed the response to the current fourth wave of COVID-19.

The Vice chancellor and the WR later visited the Public Health Reference Lab (PHRL) in KMU and were received by the Director, Dr. Yasar Mehmood. The WR handed over the lab equipment, reagents, and Virus Transport Media (VTM) to be used in genomic sequencing for COVID-19 variants. The hand over ceremony was witnessed by among others; the Head of WHO sub office KPK, Dr. Babar Alam, and CEO Health care commission KPK, Dr. Maqsood Ali Khan.

In his remarks, the vice chancellor, KMU appreciated WHO Pakistan continuous support to the government in the COVID 19 response.
