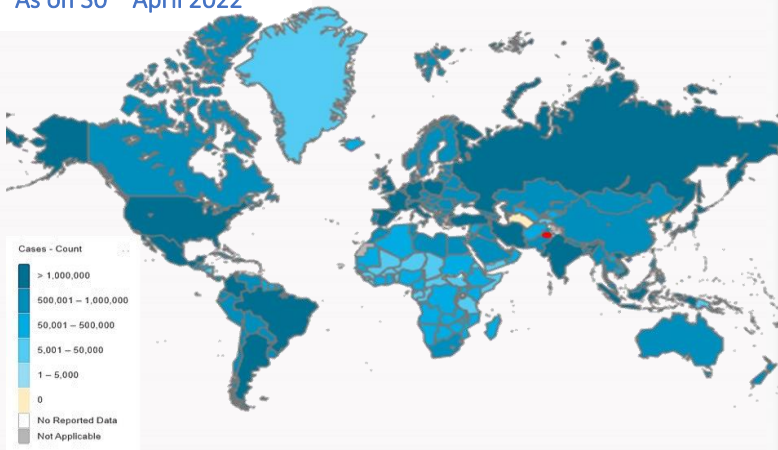

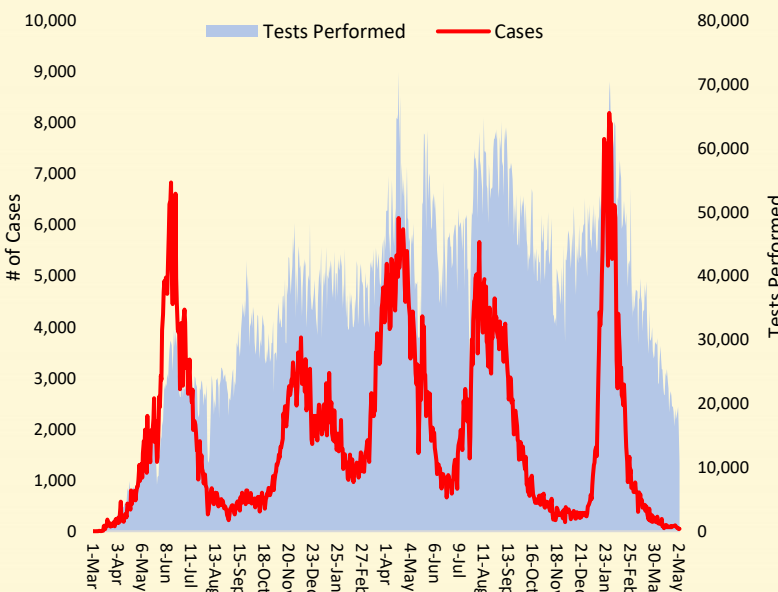

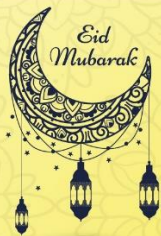

# Meetings & Coordination



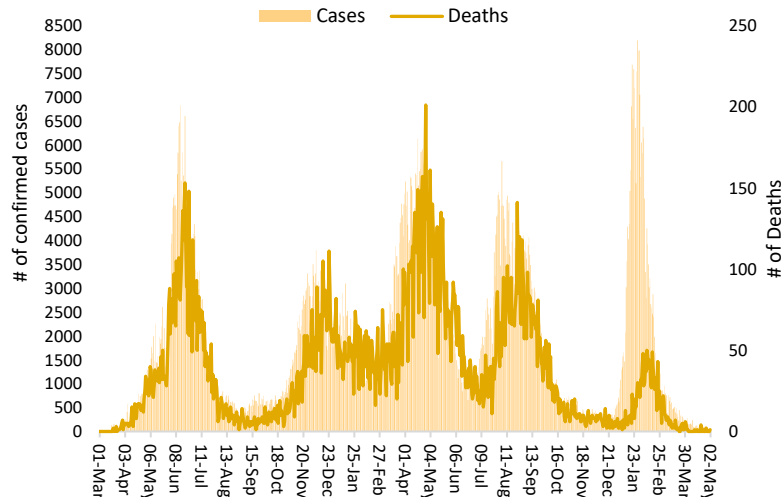
