





Meetings and Coordination





On 1st February 2022, the Provincial Expanded Programme on Immunization (EPI), Sindh health department in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan launched a door-to-door vaccination campaign for COVID-19 in Sindh Province. This campaign will run from February 1 -14, 2022. The campaign was inaugurated by Madam Minister of Health and Population Welfare of Sindh Dr Azra Fazal Pechuho. Head of WHO Sub Office Sindh, Dr Sara Salman joined the inauguration ceremony.

It is expected that through this campaign 12,748,123 citizens above 12 years of age will receive their first dose while 5,712,014 citizens will receive their second dose of the vaccine, making a total target of 18,460,137. During this campaign, more than 10,988 health professionals and social mobilizers are involved. This is a joint venture with WHO, EPI Sindh, NCOC and Health Department of Sindh.
