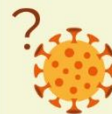

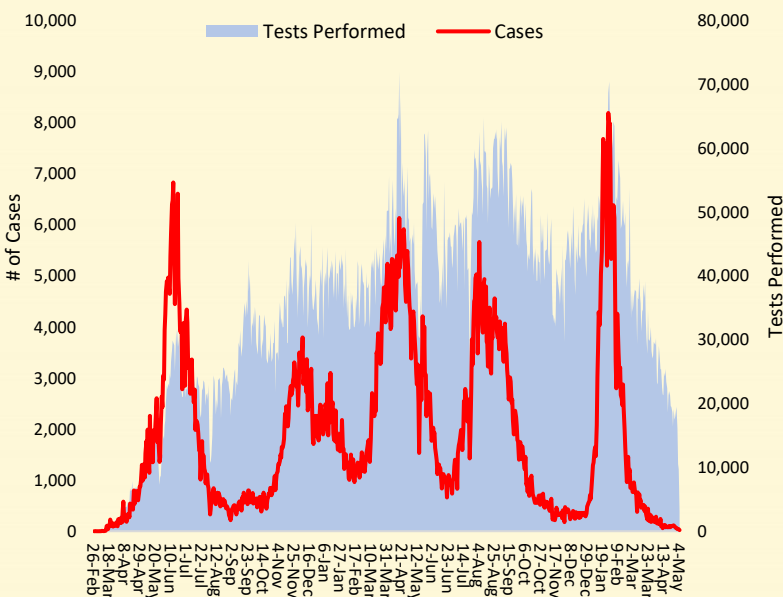

## Meetings & Coordination



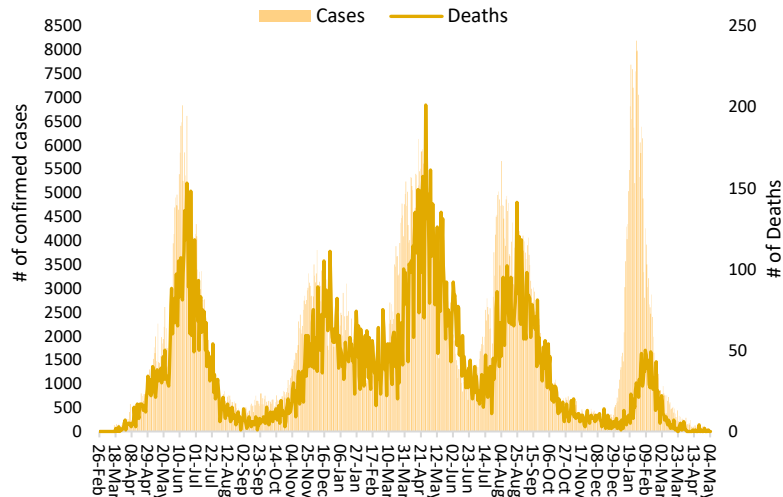
On 28th April 2022, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala accompanied by the Additional Director Health Karachi Dr Saqib Sheikh and the District Health Officer Central Karachi Dr Muzaffar Odho visited Union Council Kalyana, North Karachi Town, District Central Karachi to monitor and support Acute Watery Diarrhea (AWD) awareness session being conducted by the Lady Health Supervisor (LHS) to mothers.

In his remarks, Dr Palitha appreciated LHS for the work they are doing to sensitize the population on AWDs. He revealed that WHO has trained over 19 LHS in District Central Karachi. The WR donated Oral Rehydration Salt (ORS), Aquatabs and 10,000 brochures with messages on AWD to LHS for distribution to the community.

Dr Saqib expressed his gratitude to WHO for the technical and logistical assistance in response to the upsurge of AWD.
