

Ministry of National Health Services Regulation and Coordination in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan is conducting Training of trainers (ToT) on Maternal, Infant and Young Child Nutrition, Growth Monitoring, and Infant and Young Child Feeding (IYCF) in emergencies on the IYCF 2021 Counselling Package. The training is being conducted from 12th to 15th January 2022 at the Health Services Academy, Islamabad. Director Nutrition, Dr Abdul Baseer Khan Achakzai and WHO Country Office Pakistan Acting in-charge, Ms Ellen Mpangananji Thom graced the inaugural session. Objectives of the meeting are to train health care providers on a combined course on growth monitoring and IYCF counselling, focusing on breastfeeding and complementary feeding; to create a pool of trainers on IYCF and growth monitoring. Ms Ellen in her remarks stated that WHO is playing its vital role in providing support for the life-saving nutrition interventions for vulnerable population throughout Pakistan. Dr Baseer appreciated the WHO support for conducting the Training of Trainers on IYCF and growth monitoring.
