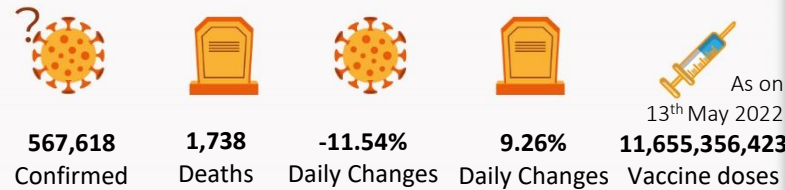

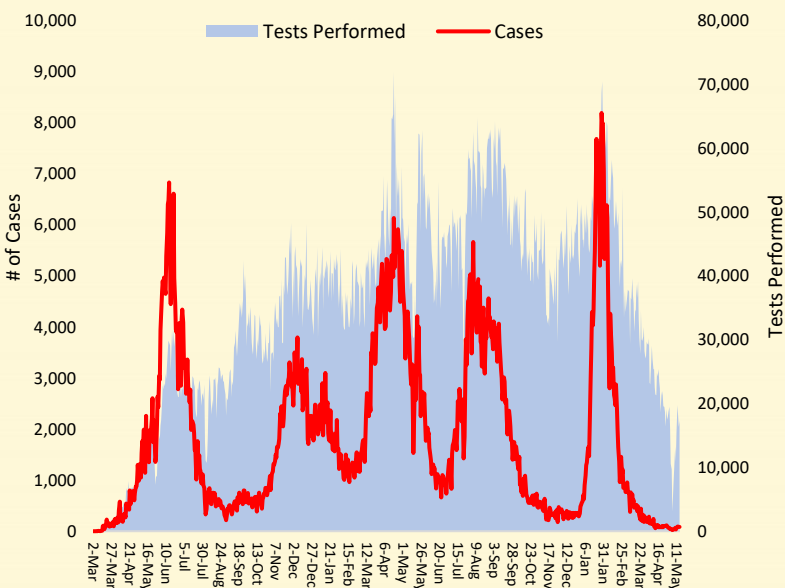

Meetings & Coordination



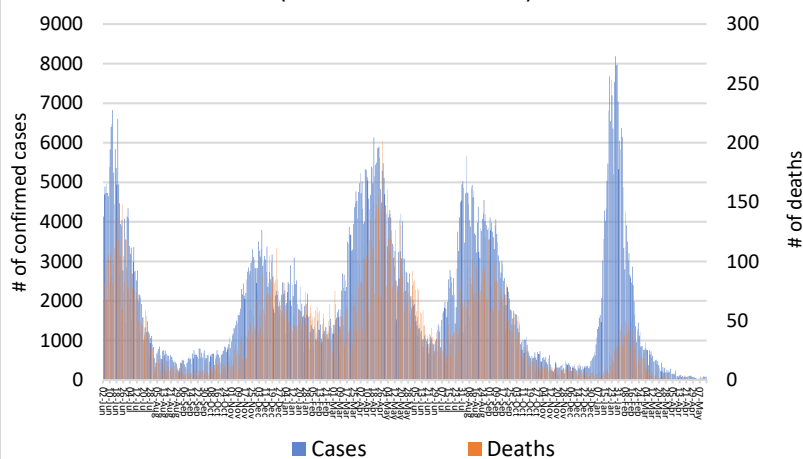
On 14th May 2022, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala met with the Director Health Services Karachi, Dr Hameed Jumani and participated in a high-level meeting on Cholera outbreak, at the Directorate Health Services Karachi. The meeting was also attended by Additional Director Preventive Dr Saqib Shaikh, Additional Director Curative, Dr Anila, District Health officers, Officials of Karachi Water and Sewerage Board, Chief Chemist. The meeting was briefed on epidemiological findings, actions taken, chlorination mechanism, water sample testing, and the vibrio cholera isolation in water samples.

In his speech, Dr Palitha appreciated the collaborative efforts of provincial Government and donated 100,000 Aqua Tablets, 25,000 ORS and 200,000 water purification tablets and 200,000 brochures for community awareness. Dr Hameed Jumani thanked Dr Palitha for WHO's extended support for strengthening the disease surveillance, laboratory and environmental surveillance and community awareness. They pledged to working together for the benefit of people of Pakistan.
