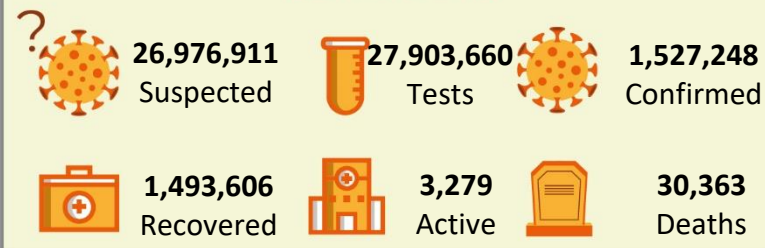

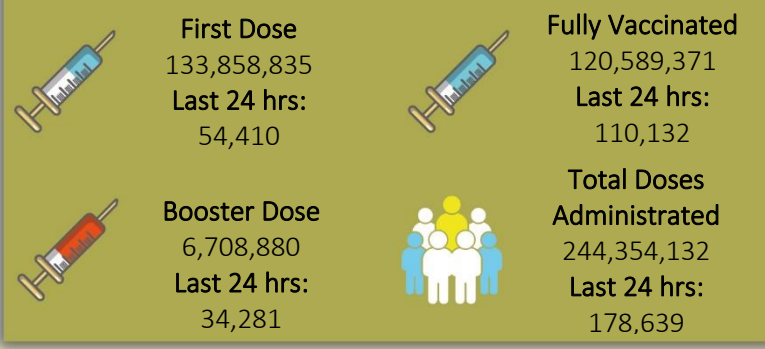

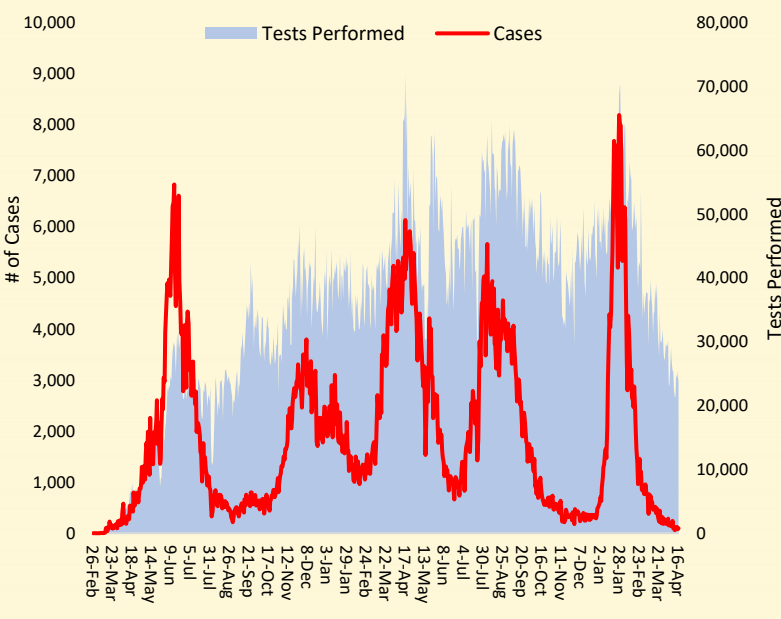
PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

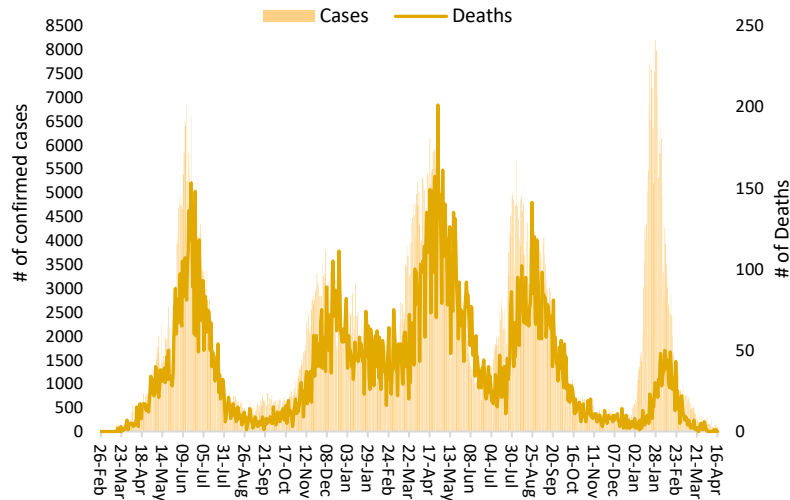
