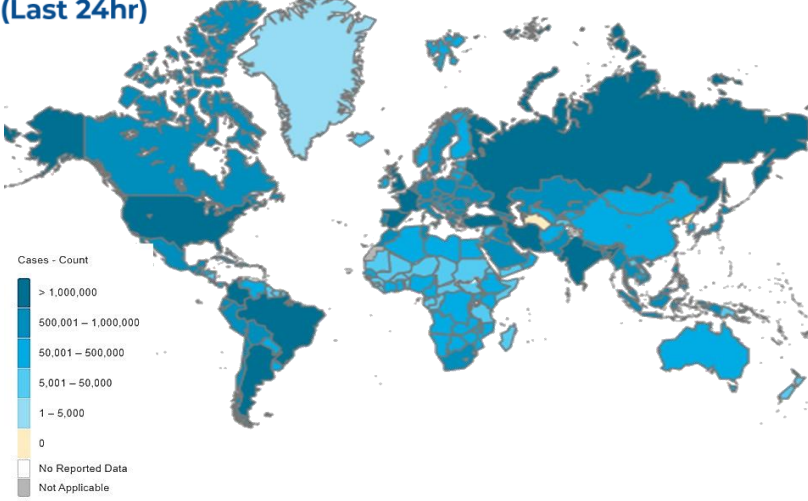
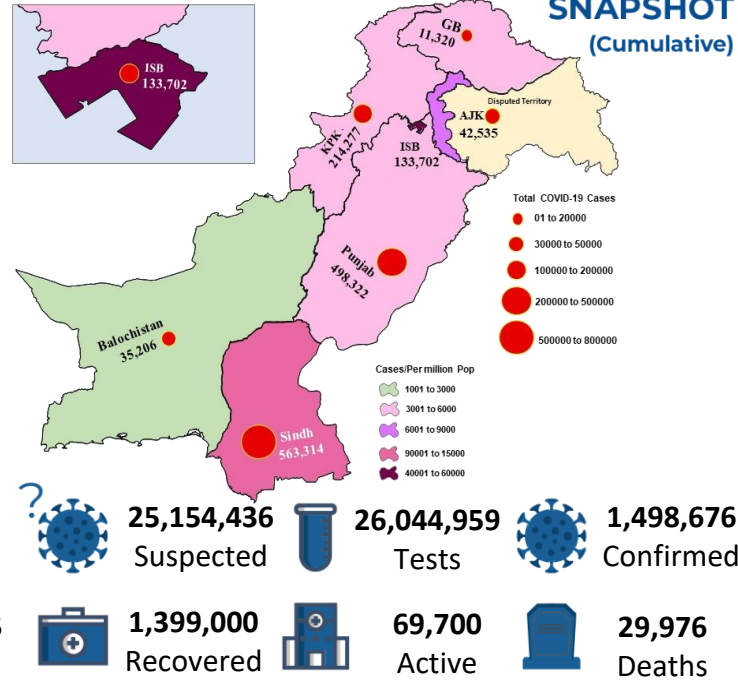

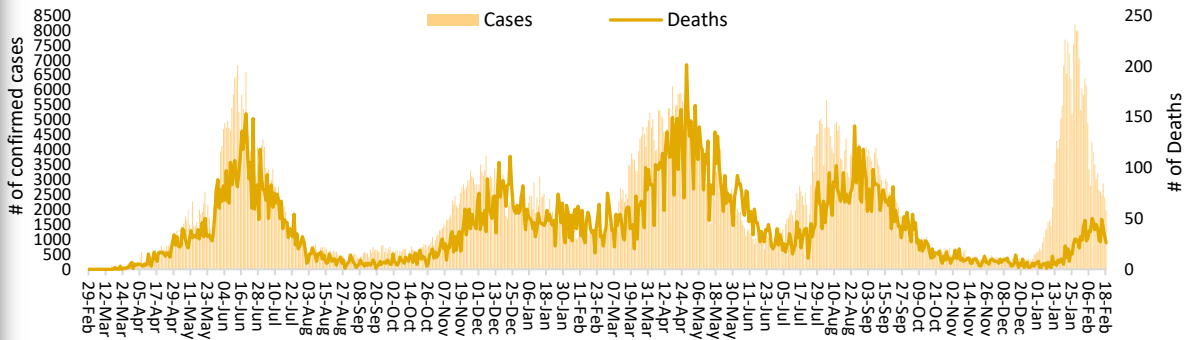

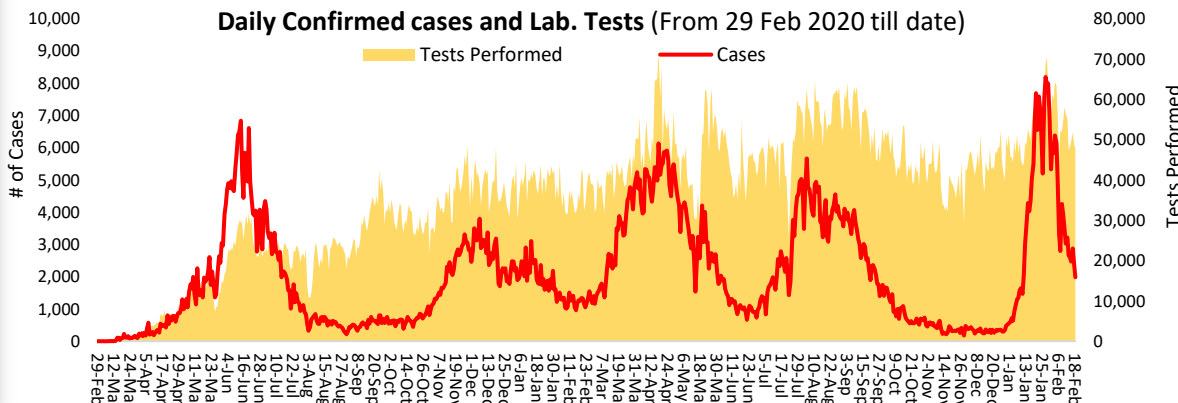

On 17<sup>th</sup> of February 2022, WHO Country Representative for Pakistan, Dr. Palitha Mahipala, and the Parliamentary Secretary for Health, Dr Nousheen Hamid, attended the closing ceremony of the three-day Community Engagement workshop. The training was conducted by the Ministry of National Health Services Regulation and Coordination in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan at Serena Hotel, Islamabad. The event was also attended by representatives from the UHC demonstration districts Swabi, Charsadda, Kasur, Larkana, Kech, Gilgit, Kotli, and Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT). In his remarks, Dr Palitha congratulated the participants for completing the training. He stressed on the importance of community engagement to any public health intervention. He reaffirmed WHO's commitment to fully support the successful implementation of the initiative. In her closing remarks, Dr Nousheen stated that the Astana declaration stands for "empowering individuals and communities," indicating a paradigm shift in our understanding of the public's role in primary health care. She expressed her gratitude to WHO for its continuing support to the government of Pakistan.
