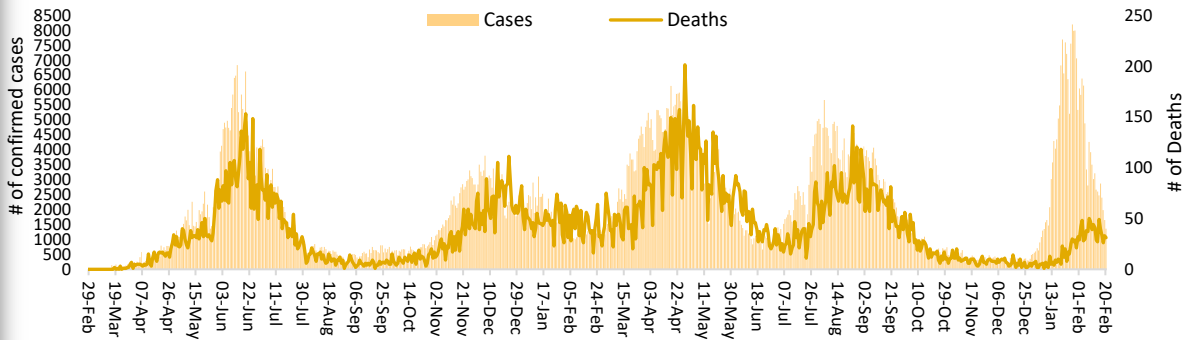

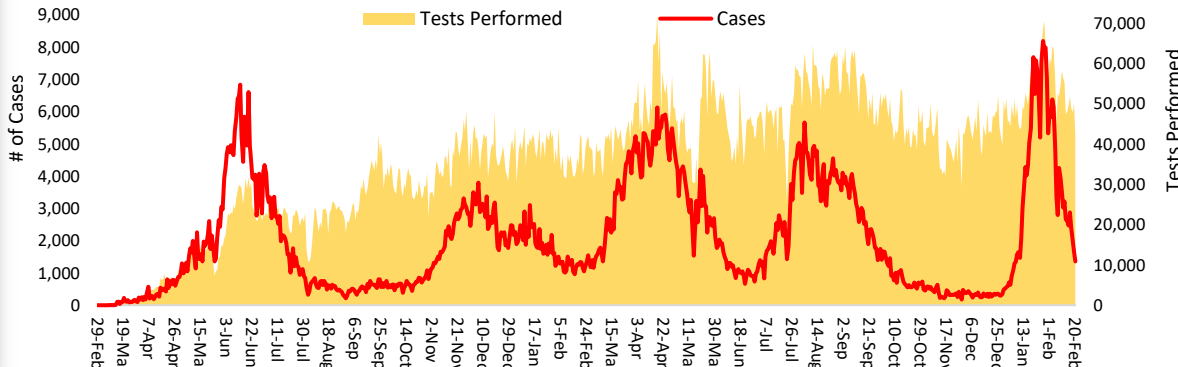

On 19th February 2022, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala visited the Integrated Mobile Health Service, for EPI and COVID-19 vaccination campaign for Afghan refugees' population at Gujro, UC-4, District Karachi East. The Deputy Secretary Health, Dr Riaz Jakhrani, Deputy Director Preventive at the Directorate of Health Services Karachi, Dr Sohail Memon, Assistant District Health Officer Karachi East Dr Jamil, and head of WHO Sub Office Sindh Dr Sara Salman also attended the event.

While in the community, Dr Palitha explained about the "wear a mask protect Pakistan" campaign and distributed free masks and COVID-19 flyers among the public. In addition, he visited the COVID-19 mobile vaccination van for marginalized populations, particularly the Afghans refugees.

Dr Palitha highlighted the fact that the WHO-sponsored mobile vans in the five districts of Karachi will increase vaccination coverage among marginalized populations, in particular Afghan refugees.
