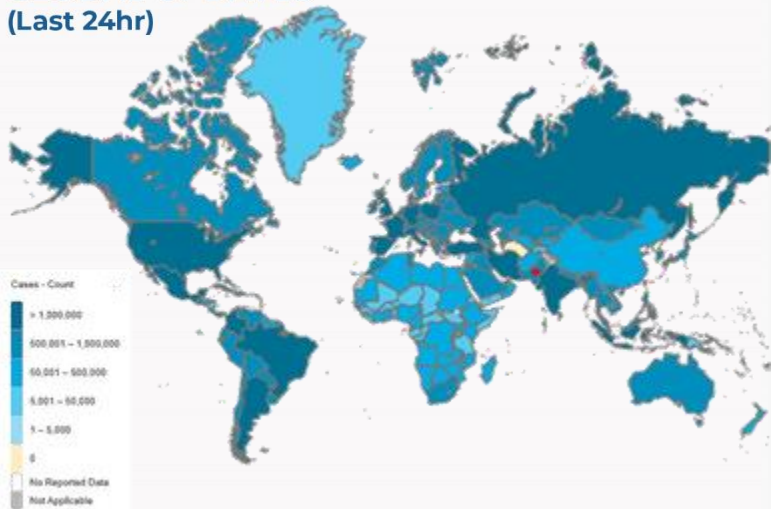

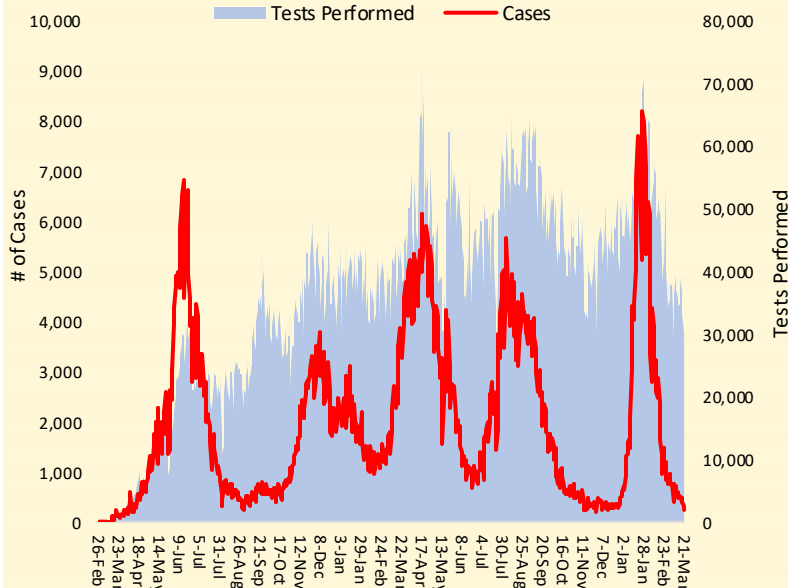

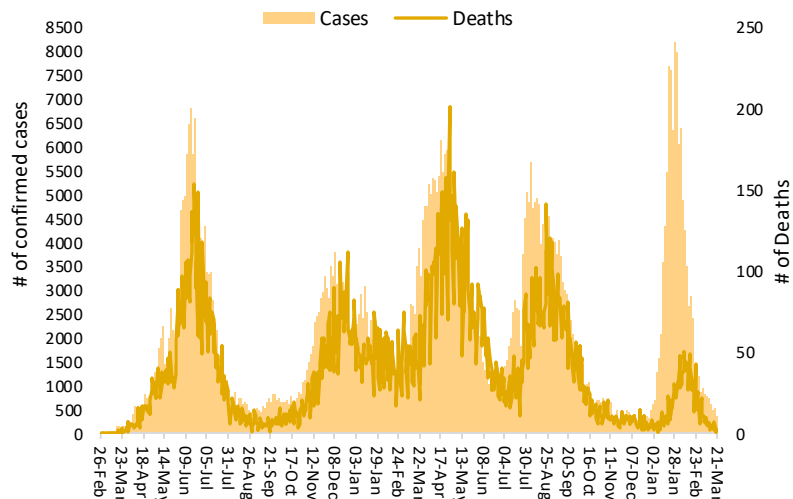
On 21st March 2022, the WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala along with the Commissioner Lahore Division Capt. Muhammad Usman, launched the “Wear a Mask campaign” in Lahore city. During this campaign they visited, Lahore Railway Station, Allama Iqbal International Airport, and Government Elementary School for Boys, Lahore, and distributed masks.
