On 26<sup>th</sup> January 2022, the World Health Organization Pakistan conducted a Health Sector virtual meeting at WHO Country Office Islamabad. The meeting was chaired by Acting In charge WHO Pakistan, Dr Michael Lukwiya and was attended by over 20 International and National Non-Governmental Organizations operating in Pakistan. Dr Lukwiya briefed partners on the current upsurge of COVID-19 cases and response by the Government of Pakistan. Dr Shaukat Pervaiz from UNHCR presented Regional RRP 2022 and coordination structure at national and field level. He also presented the health sector priorities.

WHO Pakistan Acting In Charge Dr Lukwiya thanked the health partners for their active participation in the meeting. He informed them that the Health Sector Coordination meeting will be held on the last week of every month. He requested them to continue supporting the Government.
