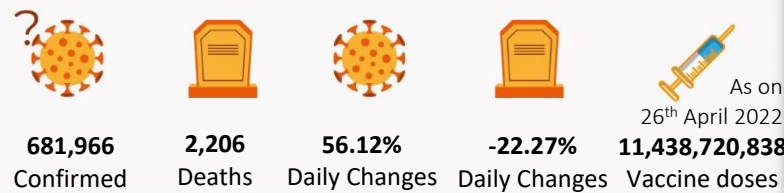
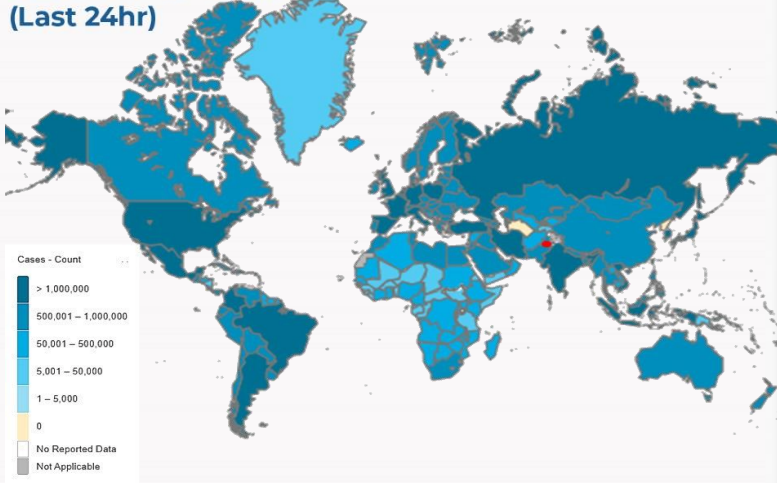

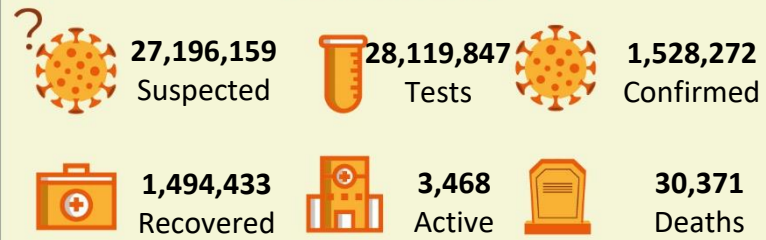
PAKISTAN SNAPSHOT (LAST 24hr)



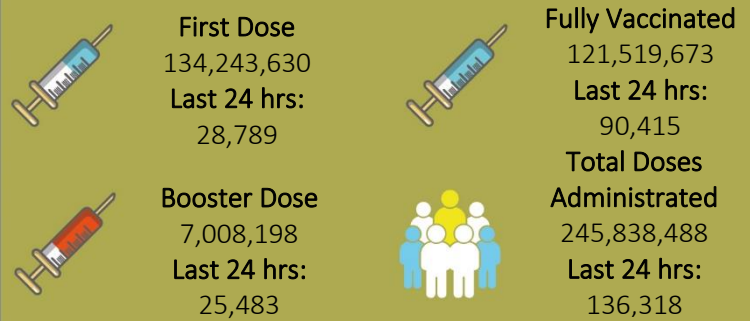

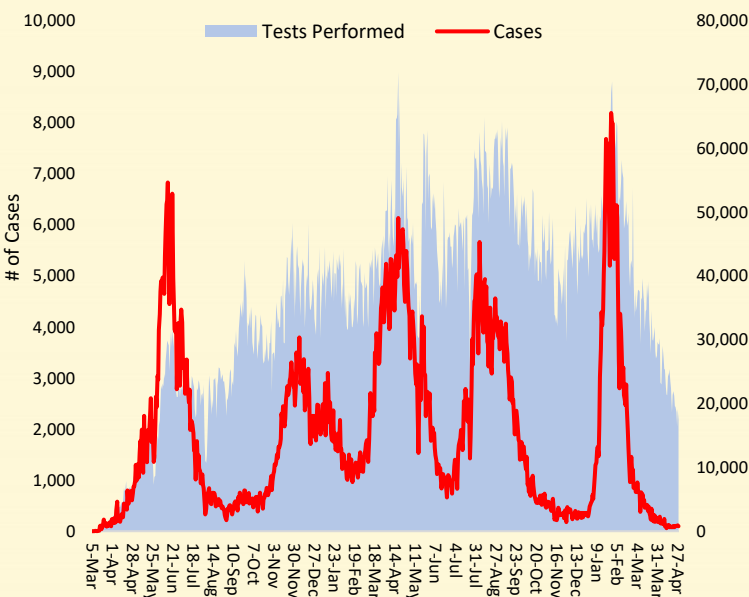
PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

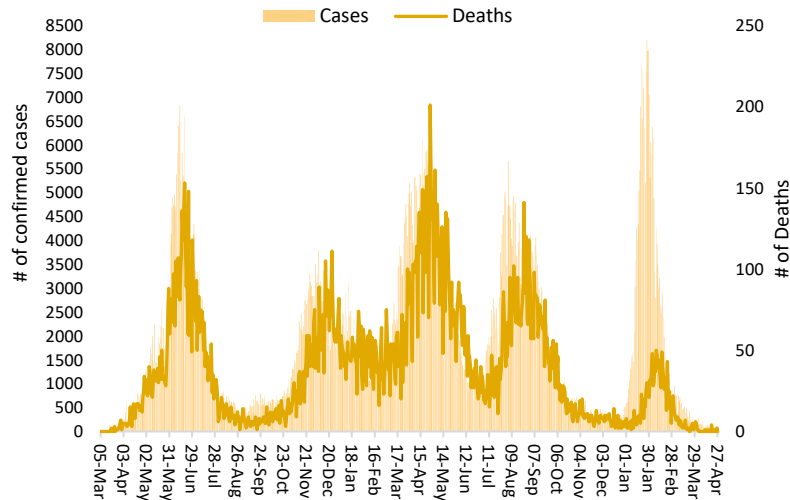

On 28th April 2022, the Assistant Director Science and Diplomacy Wing, Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MOFA) Mr Muhammad Adeel paid a courtesy call to the WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala. During the visit, the WR was briefed on the MOFA led partnerships in advancing the vaccine production agenda by Pakistan.

The two officials also discussed; Consolidation of the tasks of the MOFA led Working Group on International Cooperation and Partnerships in Vaccine Production, coordination of stake holders in mRNA vaccine technology transfer and capacity building in other domain of health diplomacy.

The WR appreciated the government of Pakistan for providing leadership in synergizing the national capacities for mRNA vaccine technology. He pledged WHO commitment to the government of Pakistan towards the cause.
