On 27<sup>th</sup> December 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala met with the honorable Prime Minister of Azad Jammu and Kashmir (AJK) H.E Sardar Abdul Qayyum Niazi at Prime Minister House Muzaffarabad. The meeting was attended by Health Minister AJK Mr Nisar Ansar Abdali, Special Assistant to Prime Minister for IT Chaudhry Muhammad Iqbal, Director General Health Services Dr Aftab Hussain, Health Coordinator Asma Andrabi and senior officials of the Department of Health.

After the meeting Dr Palitha handed over 6 ambulances, 2 cold chain equipped 4X4 vehicles and medical equipment to the Health Department for strengthening health care for the vulnerable people of AJK.

In his remarks H.E Sardar Abdul Qayyum expressed his gratitude to the WHO. He said that during natural disasters such as earthquakes, and during the COVID-19 Pandemic WHO had always been at the forefront in extending health facilities to the people of Azad Kashmir.
