On 26th February 2022, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala led the “Wear a Mask Protect Pakistan” Campaign at Saddar area Rawalpindi city. District Health Officer Rawalpindi, Dr Ehsan Ghani, and City Traffic Police Inspector Mr Faial along with their teams and the WHO officials joined the activity. The purpose of the campaign was to raise awareness about the COVID-19 preventive health measures
