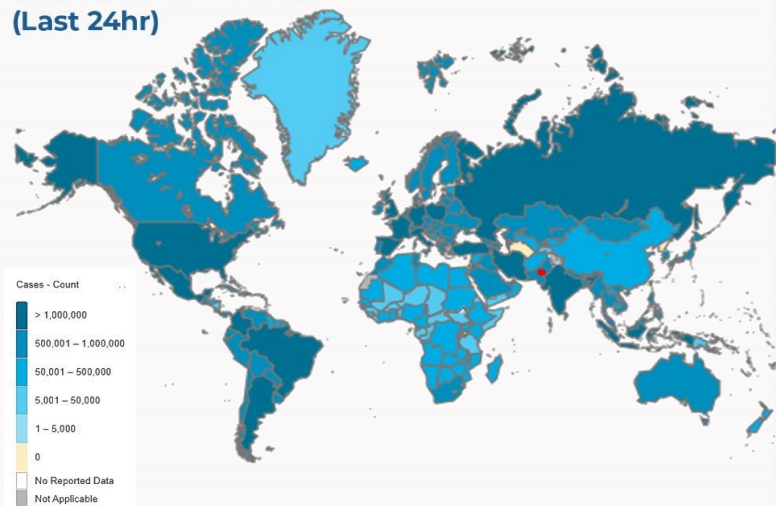

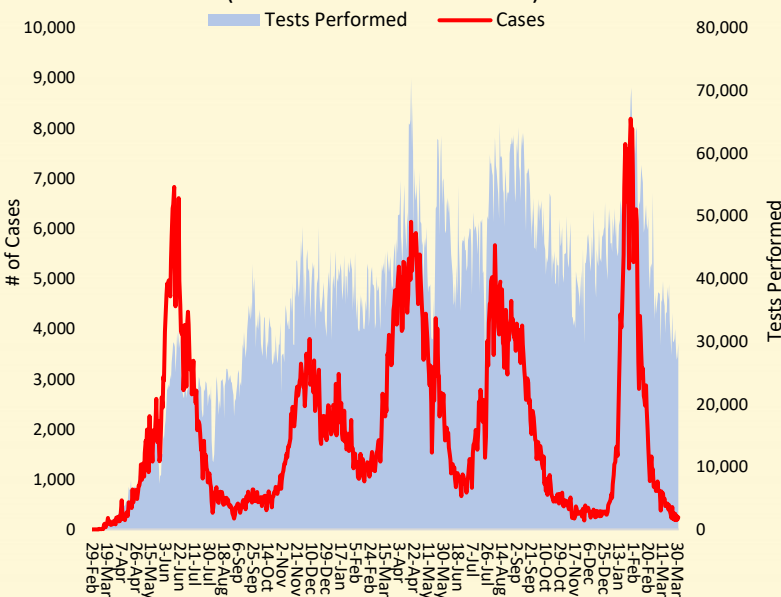

## Meetings & Coordination

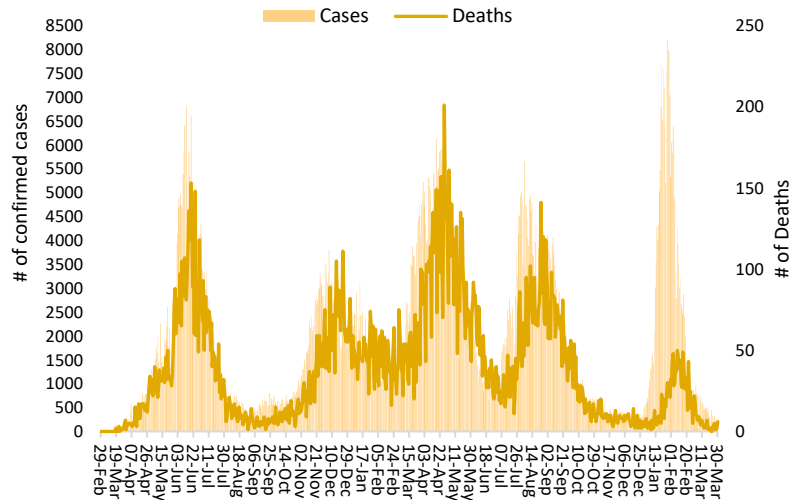


On 30<sup>th</sup> March 2022, the WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala presided over the dissemination meeting of the preliminary findings of Service Availability and Readiness Assessment (SARA) at district level results for Sindh and Balochistan. The meeting took place at Avari Tower Hotel, Karachi. In attendance were the Minister for Health and Population Welfare, Sindh Dr. Azra Fazal Pechuho, Director General Health Services, Balochistan Dr Noor Mohammad Qazi and Deputy Director Programs, MoNHSR&C Dr Sabeen Afzal.

In his remarks, WR Pakistan appreciated the health workers and partners for their valuable contributions and support throughout the process. He noted that the findings of SARA will provide baseline information for planning at district, provincial and national levels and facilitate the implementation of the EPHS.
