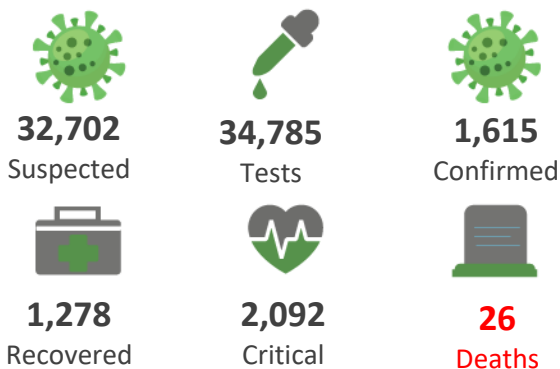


TOTAL CASES & CASES PER MILLION POP.



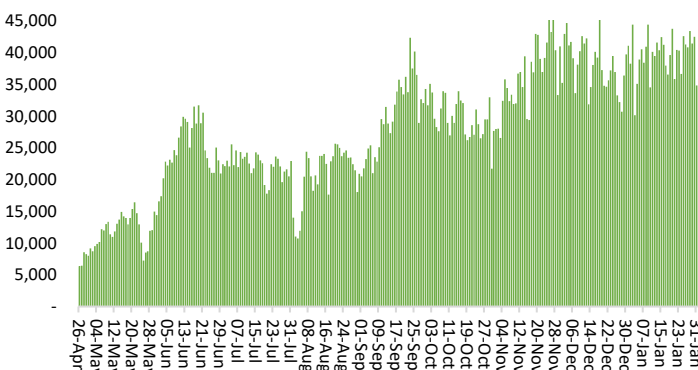
Pakistan reported **1,615** new cases of COVID-19 on **31 January 2021**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **546,428** with **11,683** deaths (**CFR: 2.14%**). Out of the total **33,493** currently active cases **2,541** cases are hospitalized.

PAKISTAN UPDATES (Last 24hr)



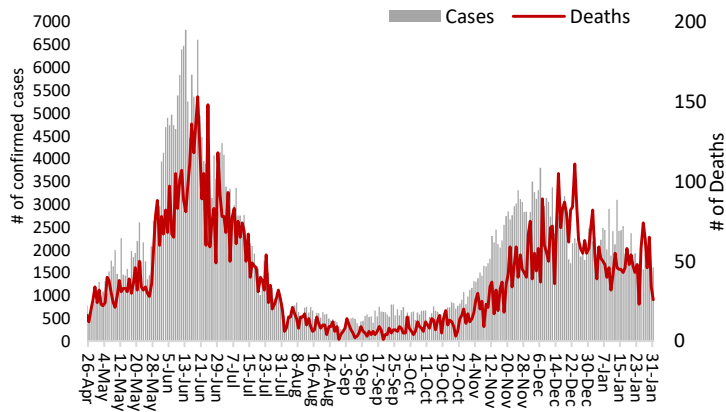
LAB TEST (PCR + RA) CONDUCTED BY DATE

26-April 2020 - 31-Jan 2021

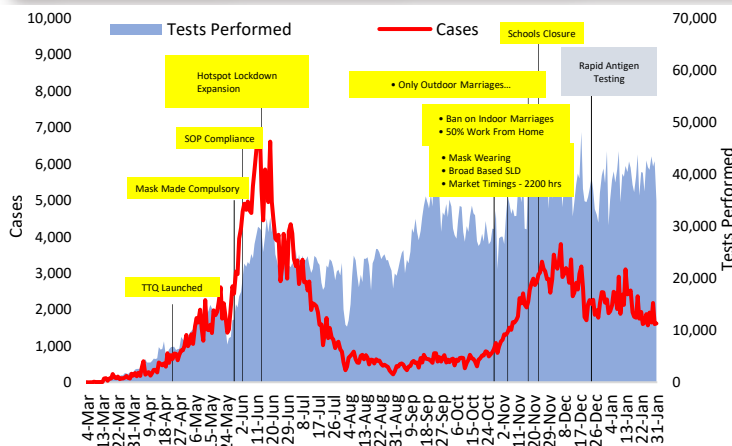


INCIDENCE & DEATHS BY DATE

MEETINGS & COORDINATION

On 1st February 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala held a virtual meeting with representatives from the United States (US), Department of State in Pakistan. The meeting was attended by the Acting Deputy Chief of Mission, Mr Richard W Snelsire; Country Director CDC Pakistan Dr Christie Reed; Director Health Office USAID Pakistan, Dr Enilda Martin; Coordinator, Office of Economic and Development Assistance, Mr Michael Patrick Ellsworth; Econ Officer, Mr Mike Berentson; U.S. Embassy; Budget Specialist, Ms Lila Wade.

The purpose of the meeting was to discuss WHO programs in Pakistan, the COVID-19 pandemic response and the vaccination plan for COVID-19, Polio Eradication Initiative, and future collaboration. WR briefed the meeting on WHO support to the Government of Pakistan in strengthening Coordination, Surveillance, Laboratory Capacity, Infection Prevention and Control, Case management and Risk Communication and Community Engagement. Mr Richard, Acting Deputy Chief of Mission, appreciated WHO Pakistan continuous support for COVID-19 Pandemic response.
