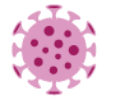

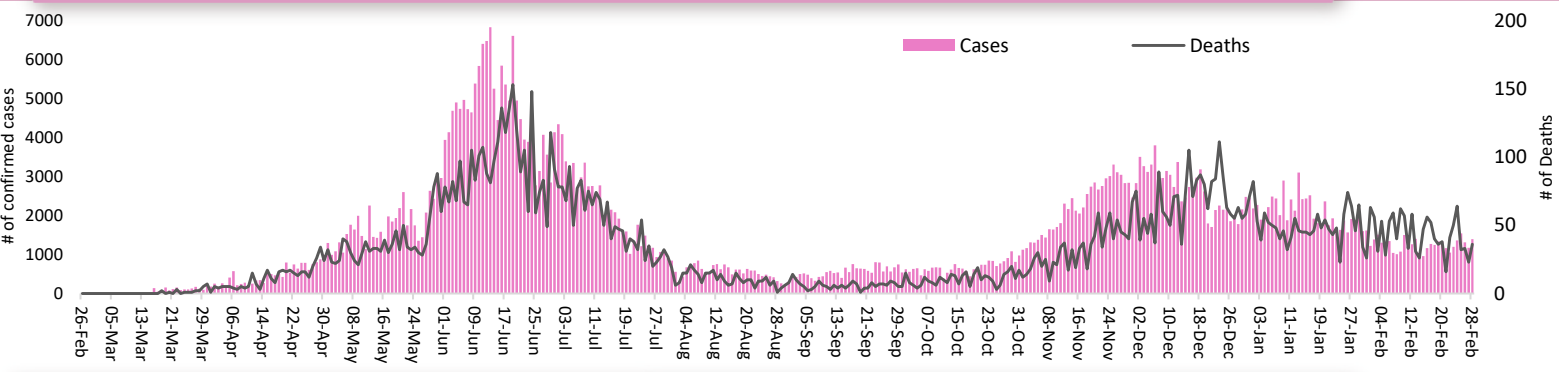

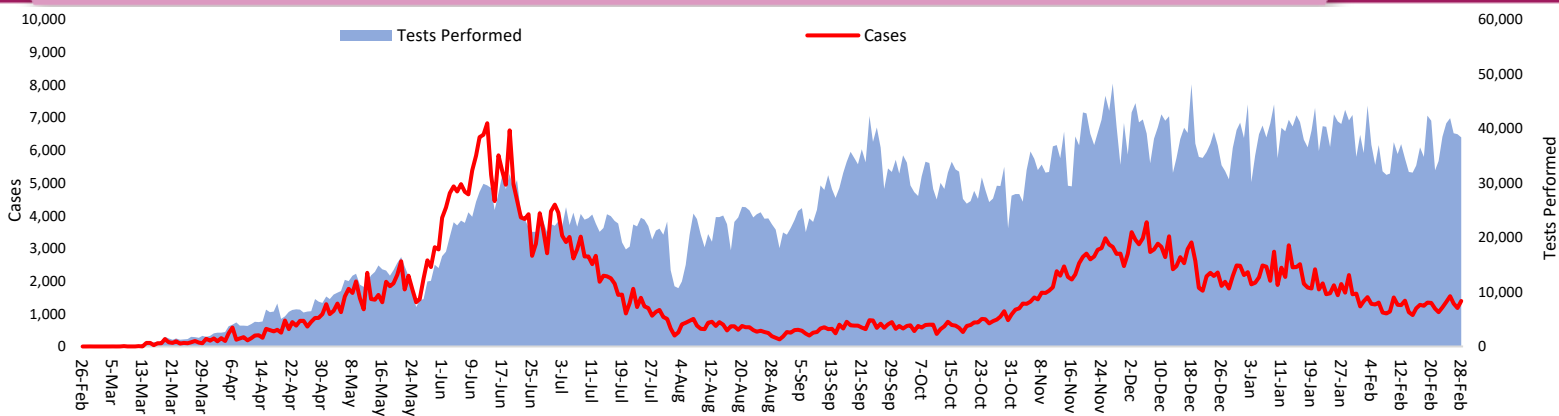

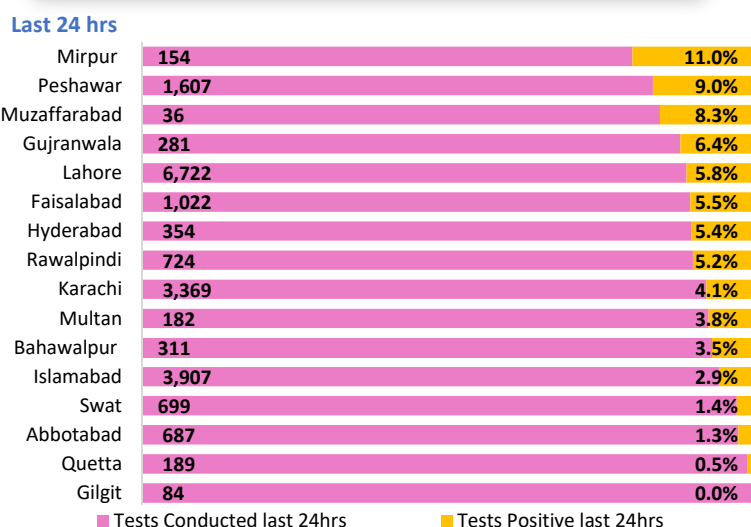

MEETING AND COORDINATION



World Health Organization Pakistan in collaboration with Shaheed Zulfiqar Ali Bhutto Medical University (SZABMU), Pakistan Institute of Medical Sciences (PIMS) Hospital Islamabad started a six days Certificate Course on Infection Prevention and Control for Doctors from ICT, GB and AJK. The training is being conducted from 1st to 6th March 2021 at the PIMS Hospital Islamabad. Aim of the course is to equip the participants with comprehensive knowledge and practical skills necessary for the practice of Infection Prevention and Control. A total of Thirty medical doctors are attending this course from Islamabad Capital Territory hospitals, AJK and Gilgit Baltistan. Twenty-one participants are from the 4 major hospitals, including PIMS, Federal General Hospital, National Institute of Rehabilitation Medicine (NIRM) and CDA Hospital in Islamabad Capital Territory). Five participants are from the Gilgit -Baltistan and 4 from AJK hospitals
