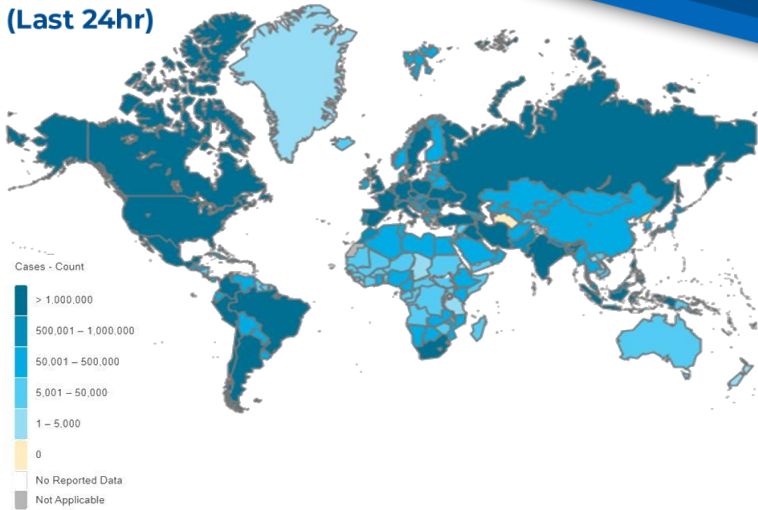


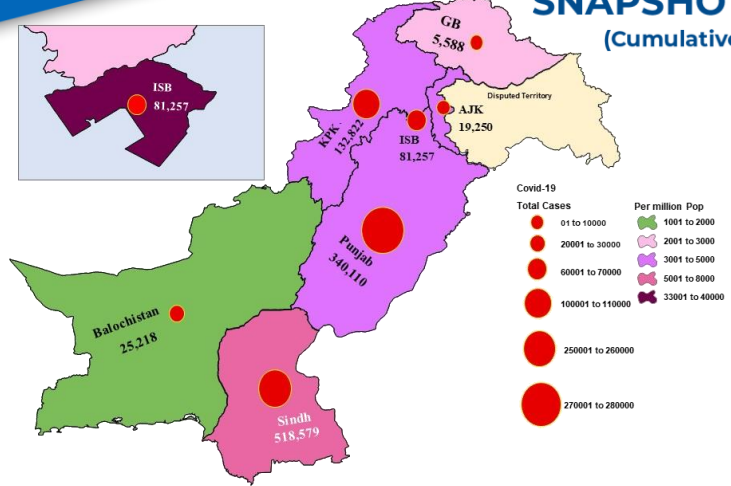

PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

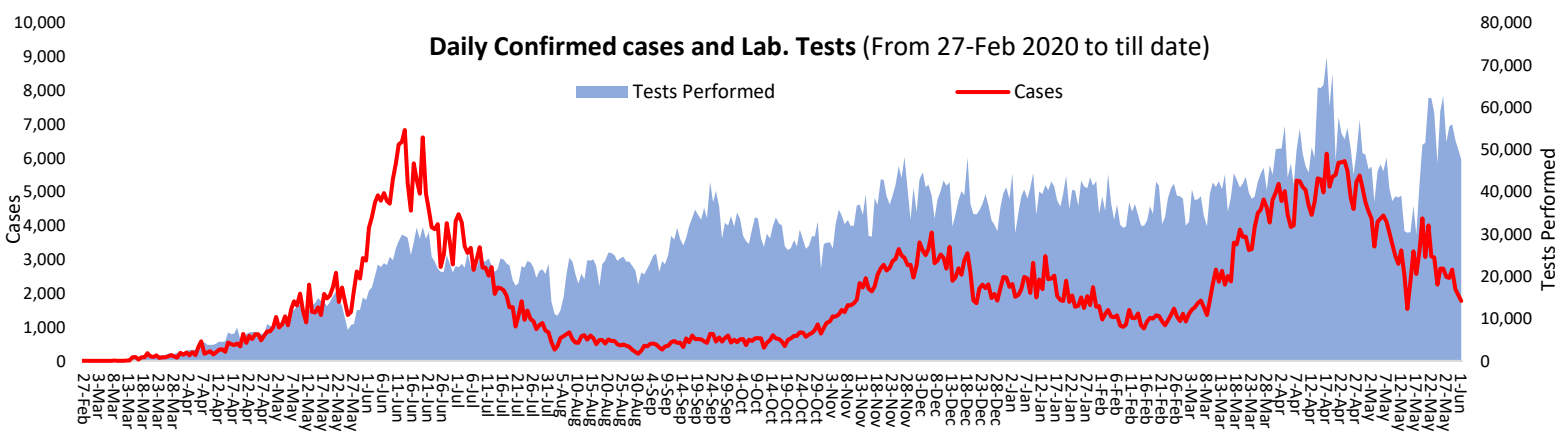
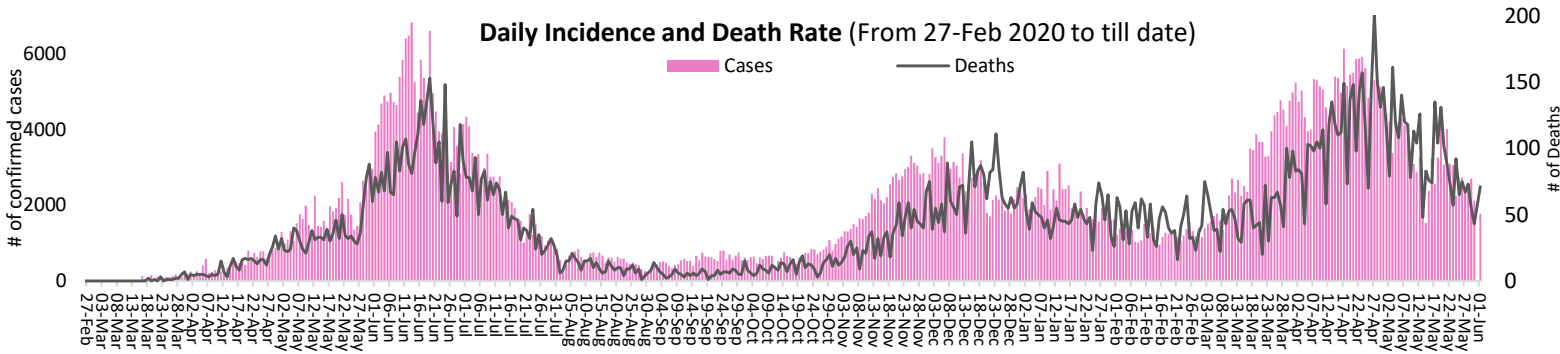

Meeting and Coordination



On 31st May 2021, World Health Organization (WHO), Pakistan and the Ministry of National Health Services Regulations and Coordination commemorated the World No Tobacco Day outside the WHO office Building, Islamabad. The chief guest was the Parliamentary Secretary for Health, Dr Nousheen Hamid, who together with WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala joined the participants of young doctors, representatives of youth organizations and anti-tobacco activists in a bi-cycling rally and anti-tobacco walk to mark the day.

During his speech, Dr Palitha briefed the participants of the dangers of tobacco to human life and noted that pictorial health warnings, implementation of plain packaging and rise in tobacco prices are proven interventions that will lower tobacco consumption. Dr Nousheen Hamid appraised the audience of Government resolve to control the tobacco epidemic in Pakistan.
