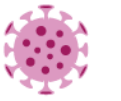
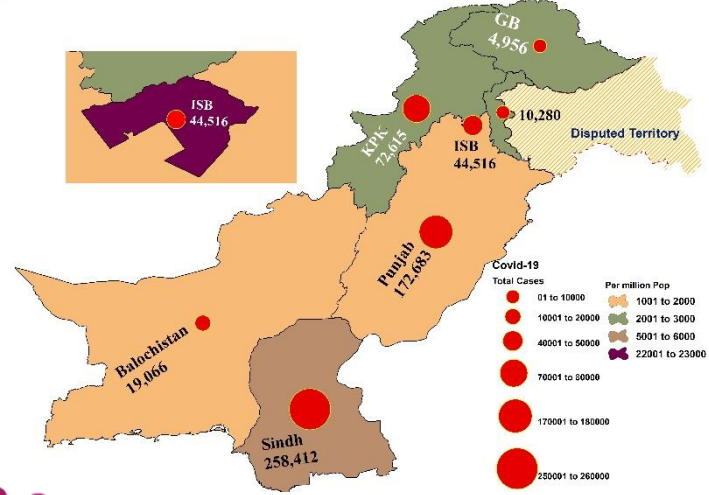

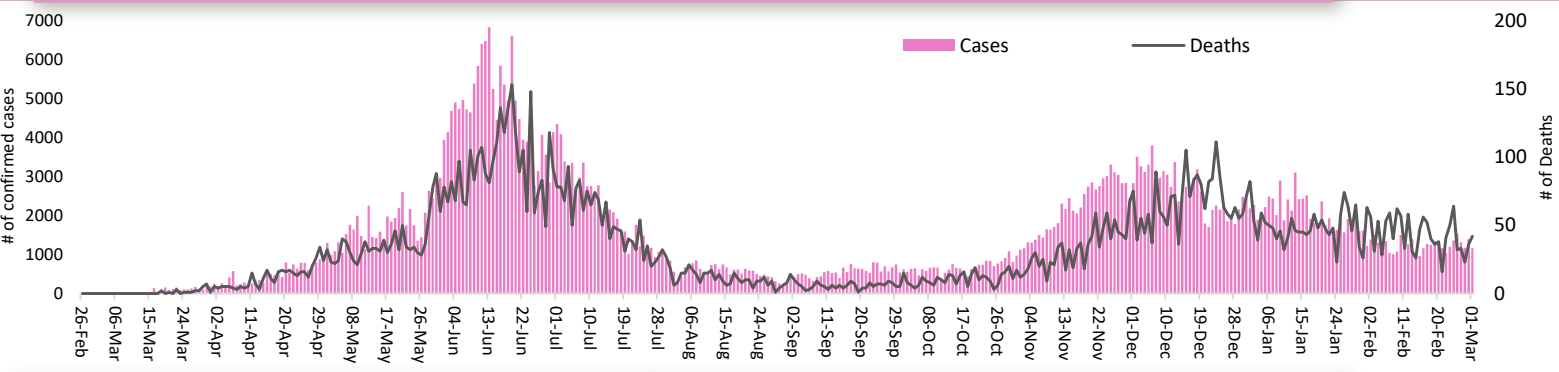

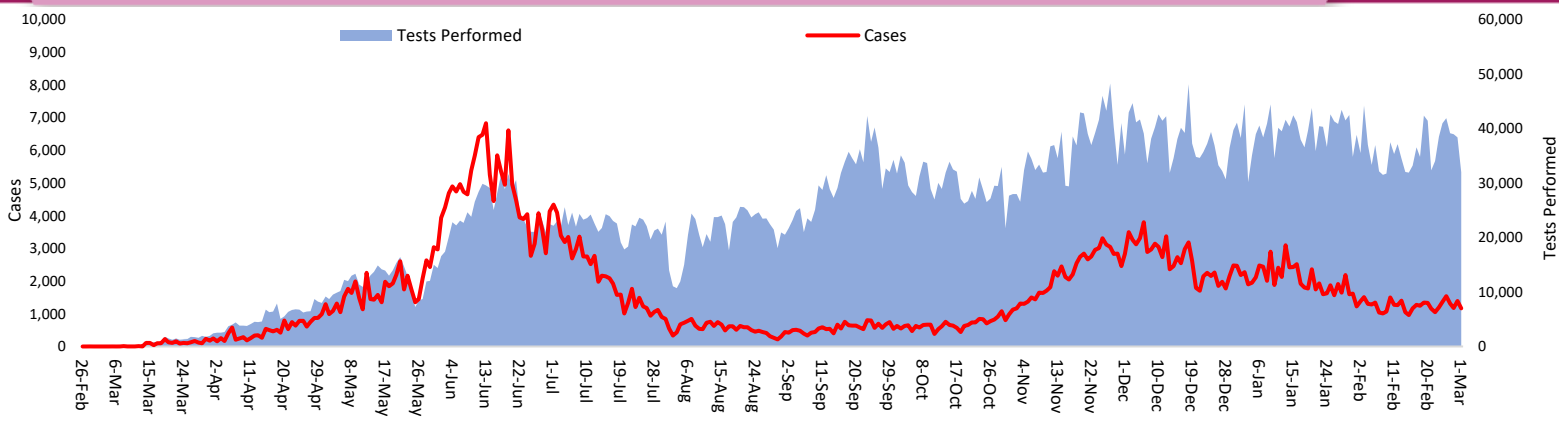

MEETING AND COORDINATION

On 28th February 2021, World Health Organization Pakistan held a meeting on arrival of the Primary Health Care (PHC) for UHC Mission in Pakistan. The meeting was chaired by WHO Country Representative Dr Palitha Mahipala. During the meeting, the Director Health System EMRO, Dr Awad Mataria, explained the purpose of the mission and acknowledged the partners agencies involved.

During his speech, Dr Palitha stated that it is the right and most opportune time for the mission to materialize in Pakistan, as the country was coming out of its second wave of COVID-19 pandemic and life was returning to normalcy. The Country Representative UNICEF Ms Aida mentioned that this mission is not a product of a day rather an outcome of a year long planning. The 5th Lady Health Workers evaluation is out and now is the time for planning the way forward. She mentioned that "Dr Palitha's leadership has been exemplary in bringing everyone together".
