

Meeting and Coordination



On the 30th April 2021, WHO Country office Pakistan conducted a virtual briefing for development partners chaired by the WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala. During the meeting, the WR briefed partners on the global COVID-19 situation, Eastern Mediterranean Region, and the Pakistan situation. He outlined the Government's strategy in the COVID-19 response in the country.

He further appealed to the partners to continue supporting the Government of Pakistan response plans, especially in the areas of; vaccination rollout, laboratory testing, case management and risk communication and community engagement.
