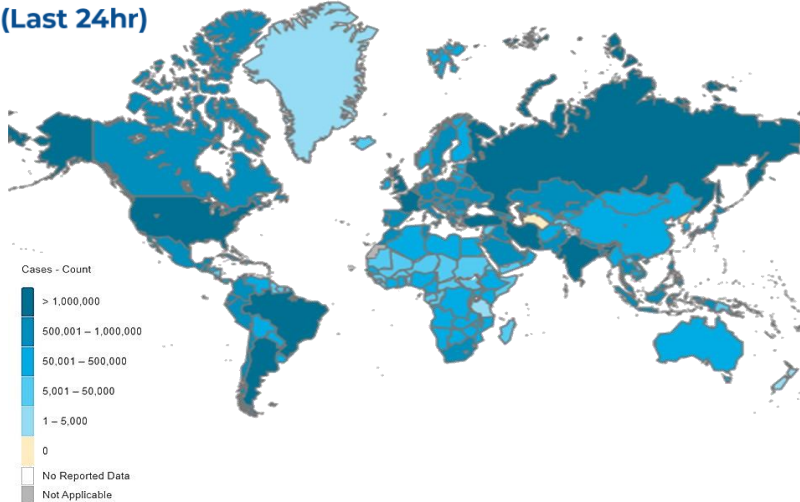

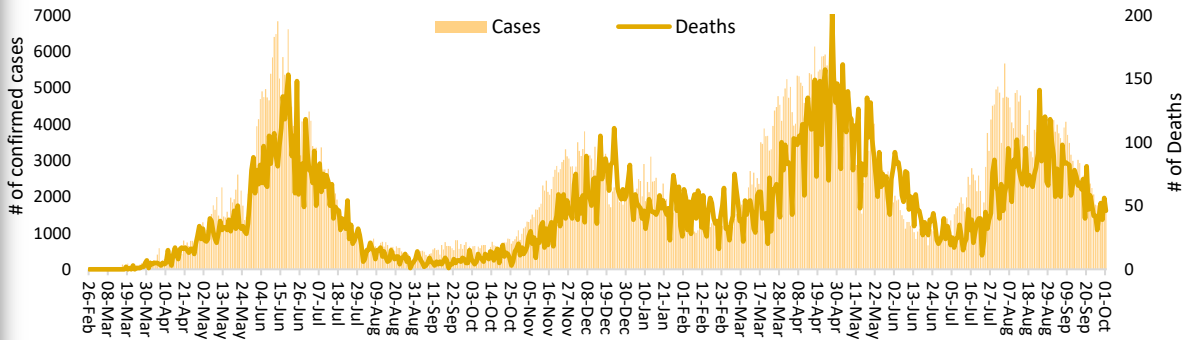

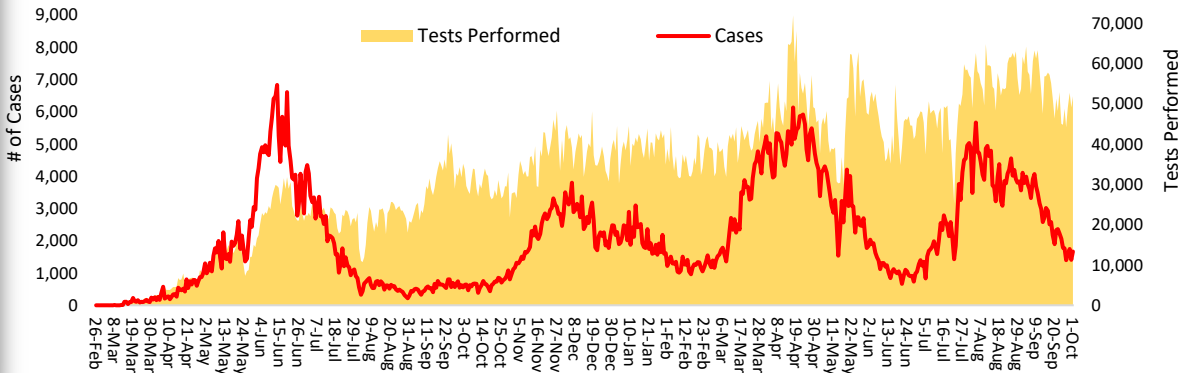

The WHO supported pilot training on Strengthening POE Capacities for IHR compliance. The training was held at Marriot Hotel, Islamabad from 29th to 30th September 2021. The closing ceremony was graced by the WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala and the Director Central Health Establishment (DCHE) Dr Shaista Habibullah. 20 participants drawn from DCHE, Airports & ground crossings, civil aviation, and Development partners (PHE & CDC) benefitted from the training. WHO/EMRO team led by Dr Dalia Samhuri participated virtually.

In his remarks, Dr Palitha highlighted on WHO support to MoNHSRC and CHE in the development of core capacities at all the 19 PoE during COVID 19 response and pledged to continue supporting the activities.
