On 2nd November 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala handed over an assortment of items that included: handheld thermal ULV Fogger machines, Rapid Diagnostic Tests, chemicals, and posters. These items worth over PKR 10 million were handed over to the Director-General Health, Metropolitan Corporation, Islamabad Dr Hasan Orooj, and District Health Officer Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT) Dr Zaeem Zia to support Dengue Control. The handover ceremony took place at WHO Country Office Islamabad.

During his speech, Dr Palitha highlighted on the Dengue situation in the country and appreciated the Government response, and pledged WHO's continued support.

The Director General Health, Metropolitan Corporation, Islamabad and District Health Officer ICT, expressed their appreciation for WHO Pakistan support to the upsurge in Dengue fever in ICT.
