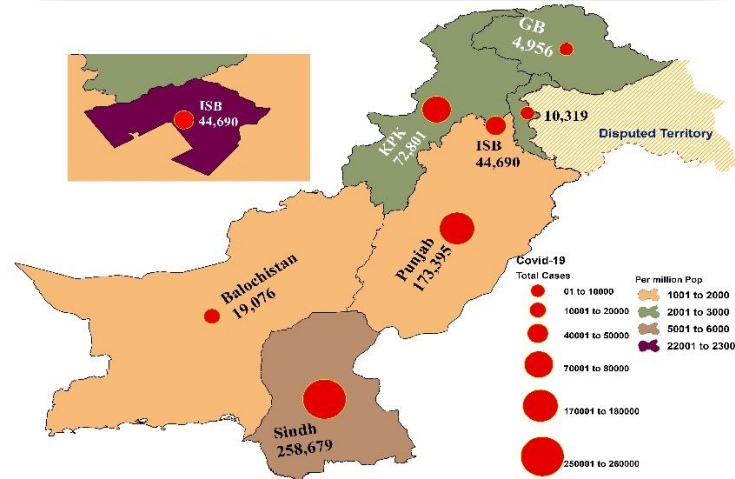
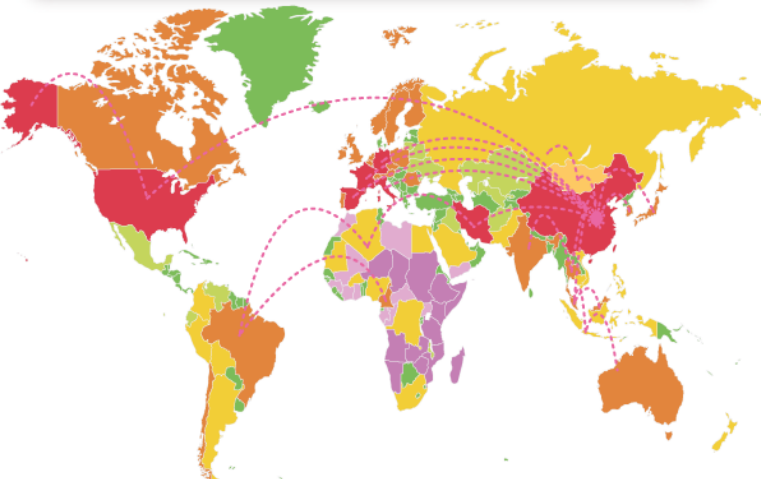

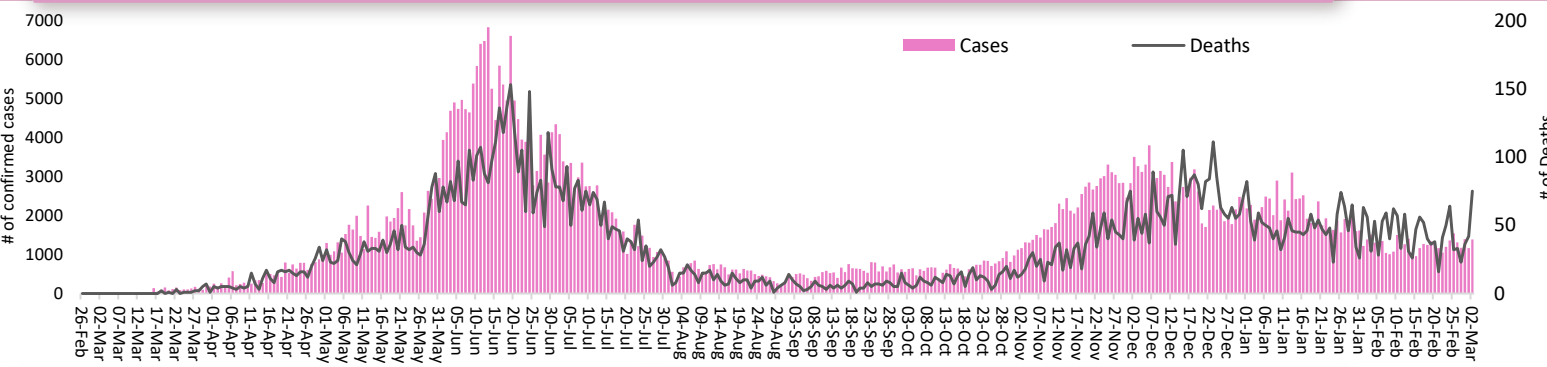

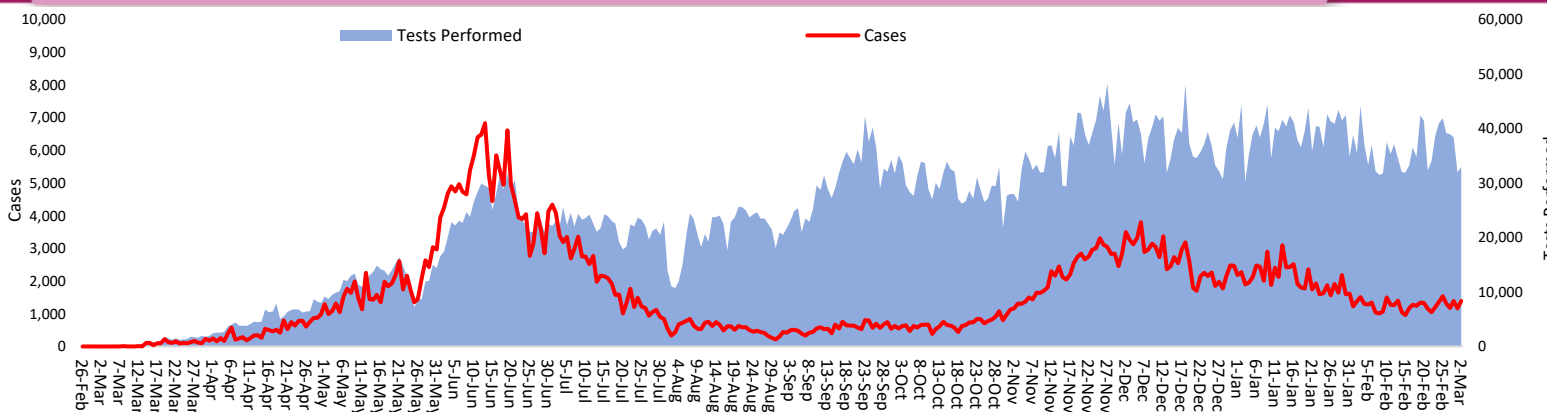

## MEETING AND COORDINATION

On 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2021, The WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala donated 02 ambulances and 150 Tablets on behalf of WHO to the District Health Officer (DHO) Islamabad, Dr Zaeem Zia. The handing-over ceremony was held at the WHO country office Islamabad. Dr Palitha appreciated the DHO and his team for the good work they are doing to respond to COVID-19 outbreak.

Purpose of the ambulance's donation is to support strengthen the Government of Pakistan COVID-19 response efforts to ensuring timely and safe referral of patients in Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT). The Tablets donated as part of Universal Health Coverage (UHC) benefit package for 15 hospitals in ICT to update the electronic record system through the LHWs.

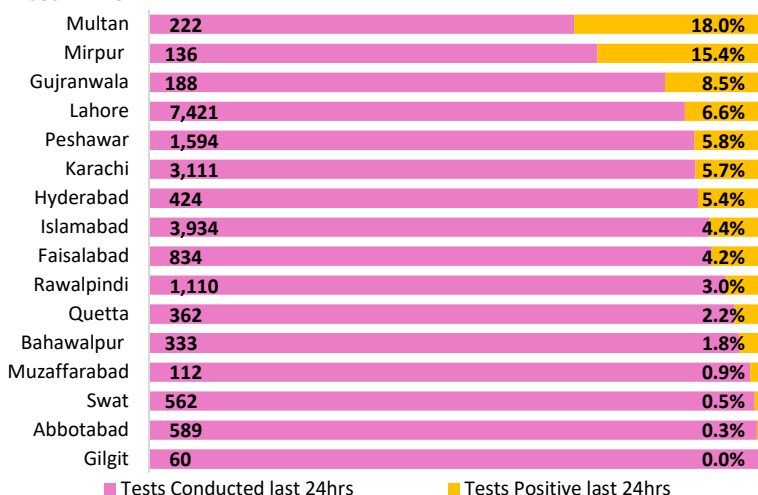
