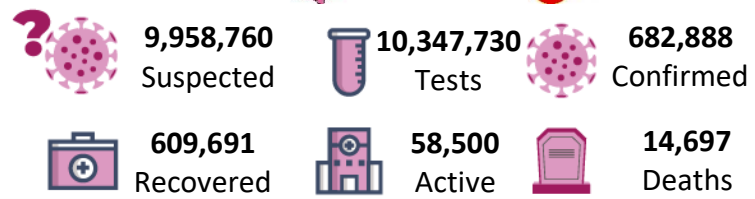

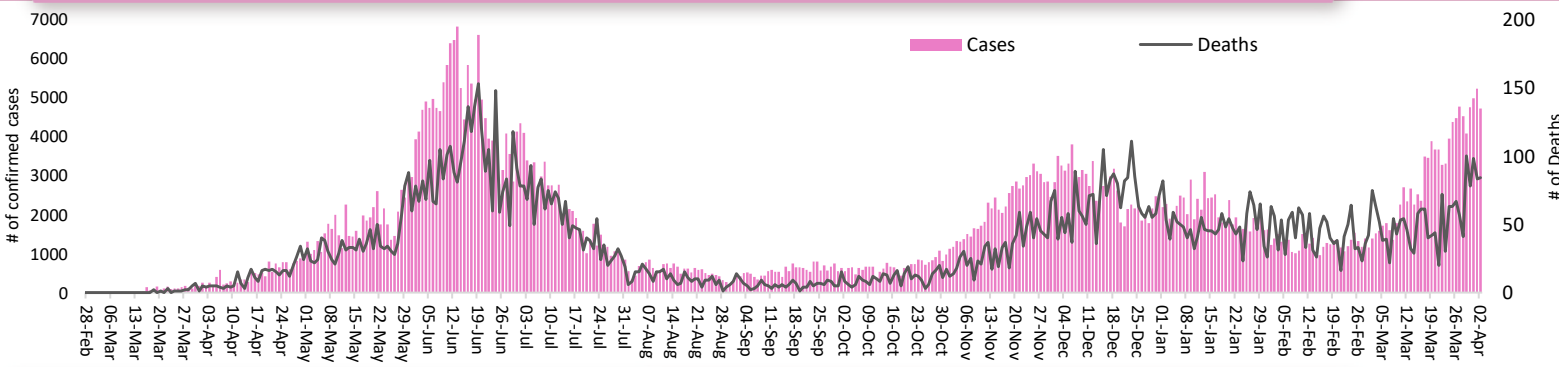

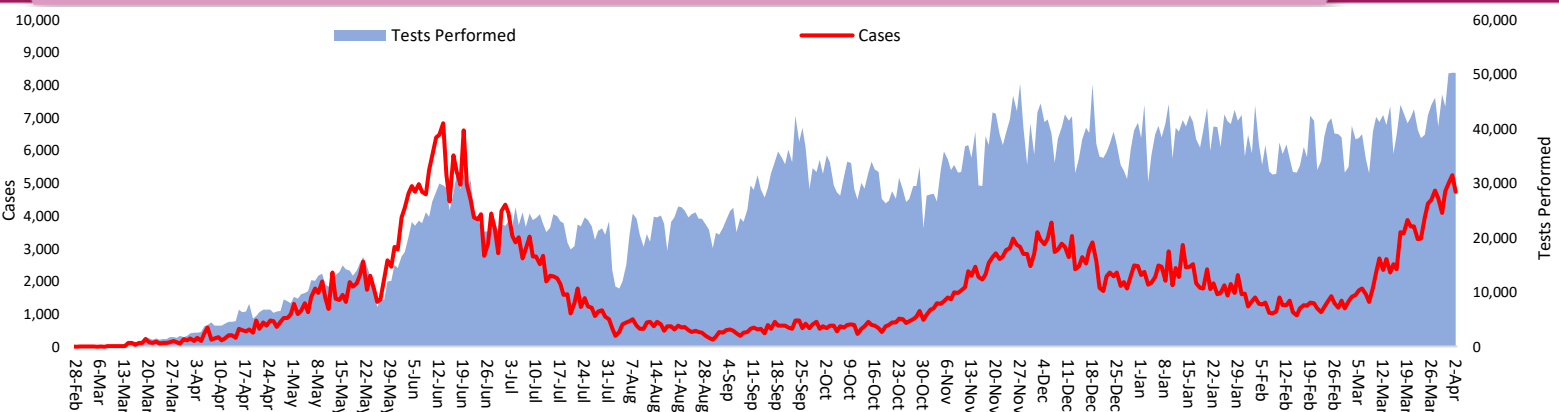
PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

MEETING AND COORDINATION

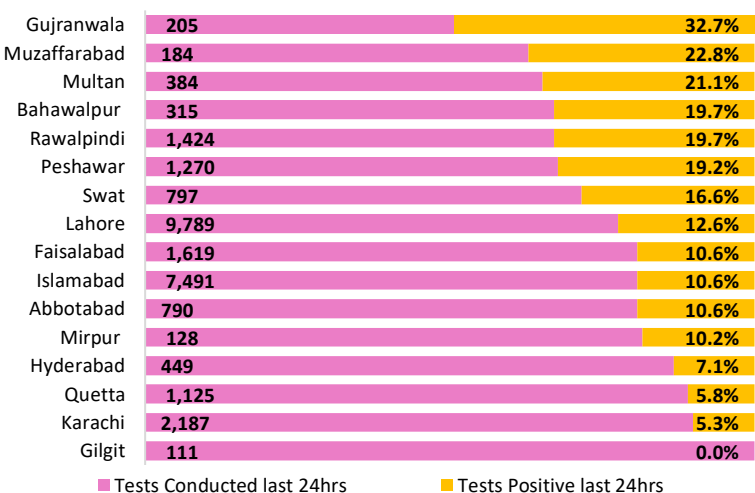
