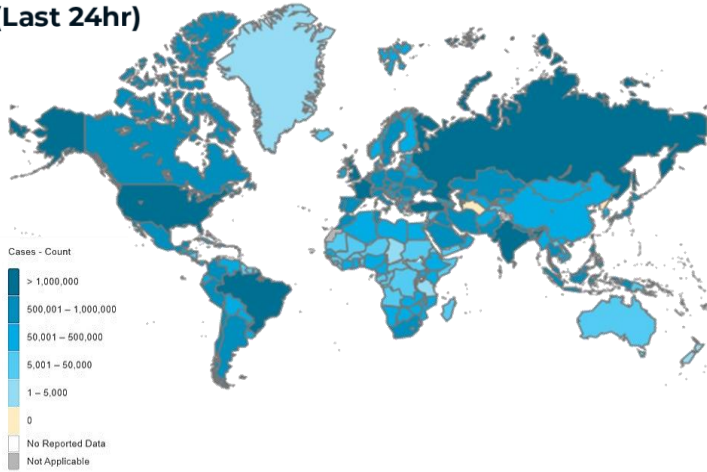




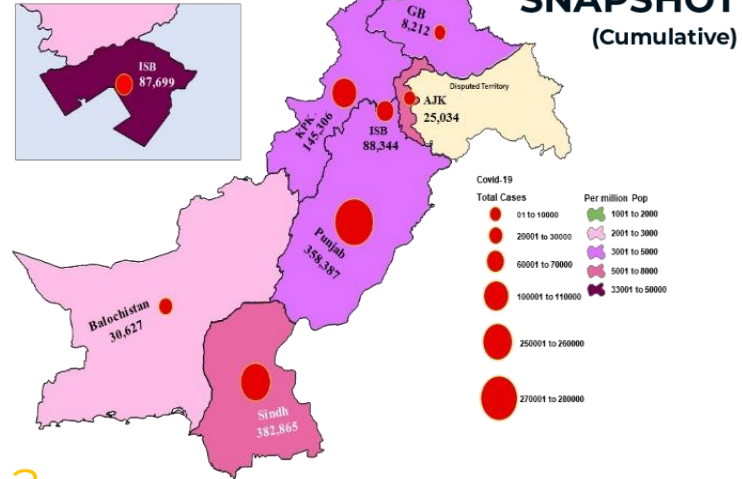

PAKISTAN COVID-19 SNAPSHOT (Cumulative)

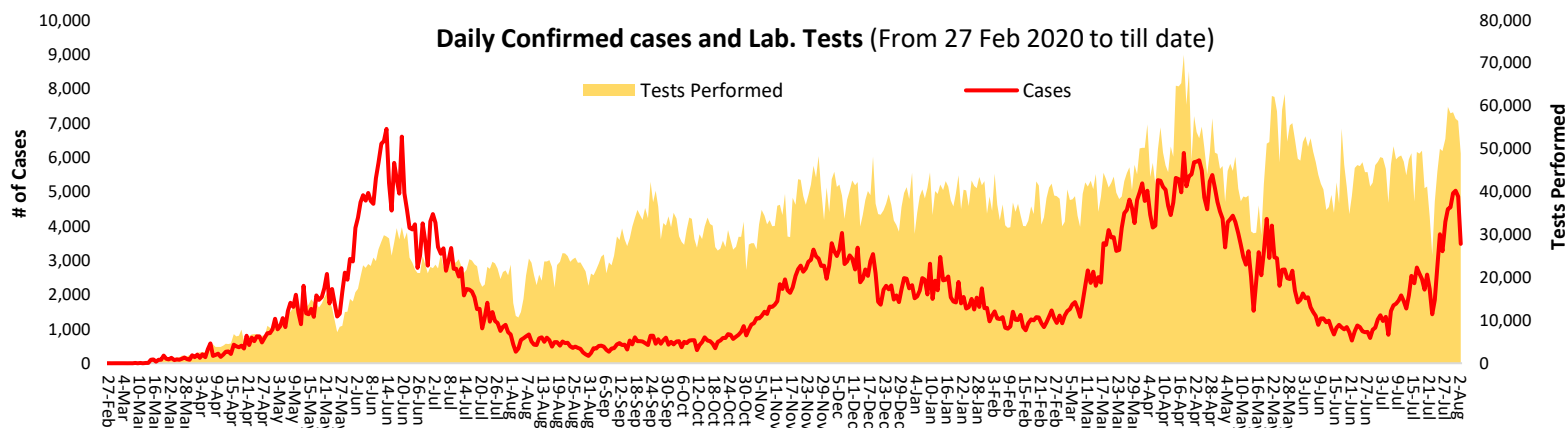
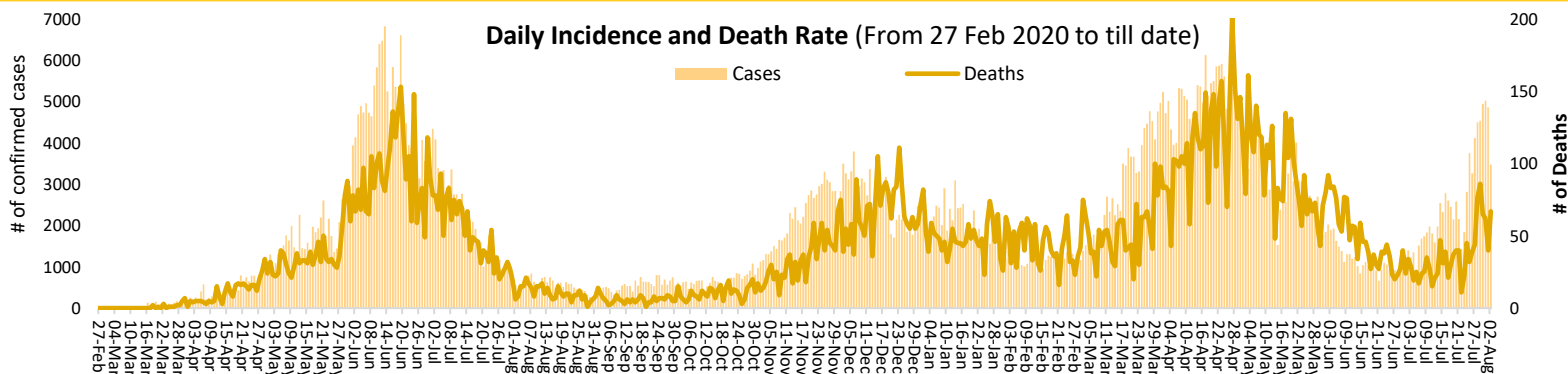

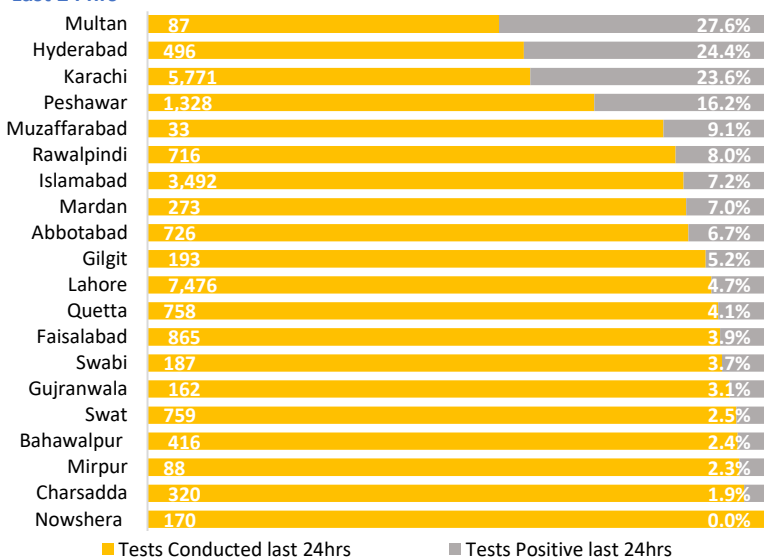


On 27th July 2021, The Population Programme Wing (PPW), Ministry of National Health Services, Regulation and Coordination (MoNHSR&C) in collaboration with World Health Organization, Pakistan and Pathfinder International conducted a dissemination seminar of revised / upgraded Curricula for Family Welfare Workers and Lady Health Visitors at Pearl Continental Hotel, Bhurban Murree.

The revised curriculum has been approved by Pakistan Nursing Council (PNC) and the new changes include: expansion of technical content, Standardization of Training Package, Revision of competencies, job description and scope of work. The seminar was officiated by the Director General PPW, Dr Sabina Durrani. In her remarks, the Director General appreciated WHO Pakistan and Pathfinder international for the technical and financial support towards the revision of the training curriculum.
