





On 1<sup>st</sup> October 2021, the Ministry of National Health Services Regulations and Coordination (MoNHSR&C) in collaboration with World Health Organization Pakistan commemorated the International Day for Older Persons 2021 at WHO Country office Islamabad. The commemoration was graced by the WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala, the Parliamentary Secretary for Health, Dr Nousheen Hamid and Deputy Director Programs MoNHSR&C, Dr Samra Mazhar. The three officials were joined by staff from the WHO country office, MoNHSR&C, and the public in a walk as part of the day's activities.

In his remarks, Dr Palitha highlighted on the need for respect for older persons, regular physical activity, and a balanced diet, as crucial to healthy aging. Dr Nousheen reiterated the government's commitment to enhance healthy ageing through favorable policies and programs for the elderly.
