




### Daily COVID-19 Pakistan Updates (Last 24hrs)






### Executive Summary

Pakistan reported **1,167** new cases of COVID-19 on **02 November 2020**. The total number of cases notified since the beginning of the outbreak is **336,260** with **6,849** deaths (**CFR: 2.04%**). Out of the total **13,965** currently active cases, **911** cases are hospitalized, out of which **728 (79.91%)** are in critical condition. **13,054** COVID-19 positive cases are at designated isolation facilities or in-home isolation. A total of **315,446 (93.81%)** have recovered and discharged.


### Daily Incidence by Province




### Daily Incidence/Mortality




### Daily Lab Test conducted

## Meetings & Coordination




