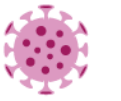

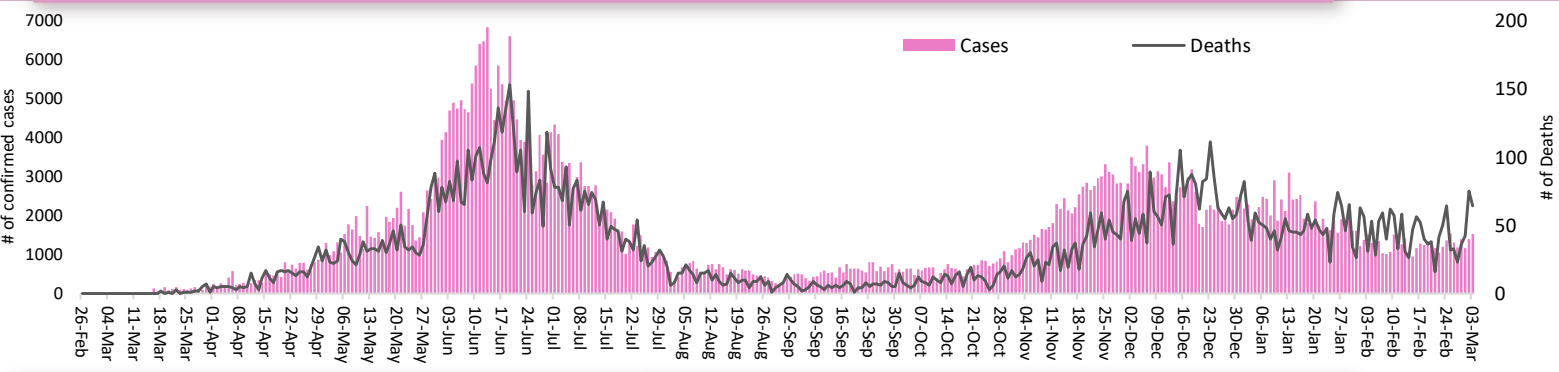

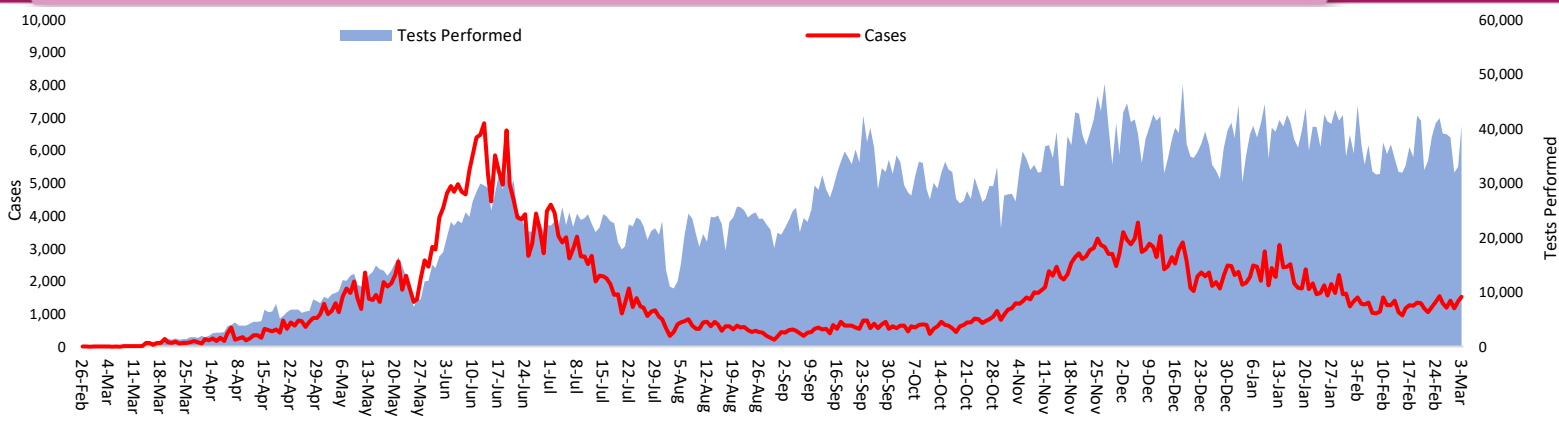

Daily Confirmed cases and Lab. Tests (From 26-Feb 2020 to till date)

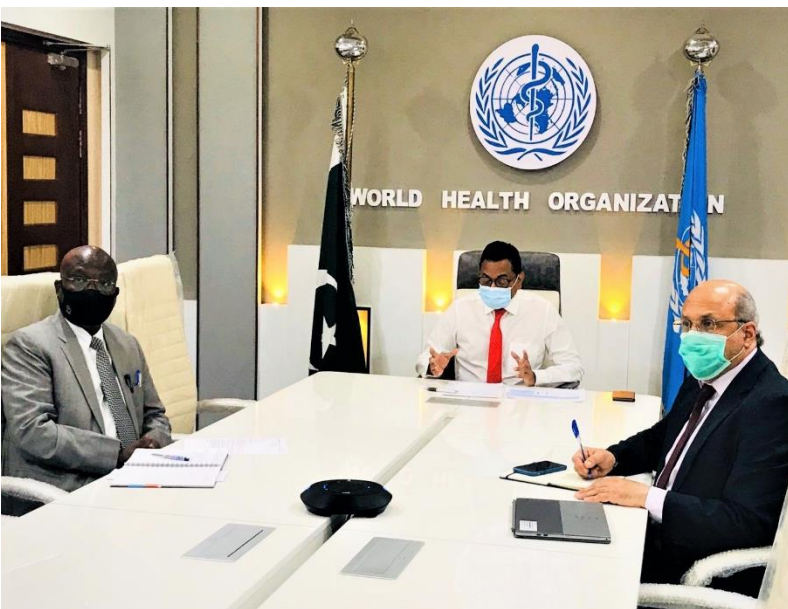

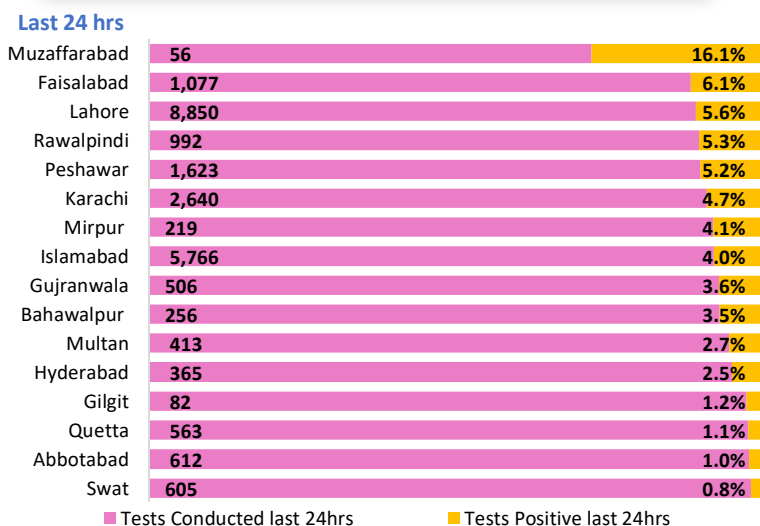
MEETING AND COORDINATION

On 4th March 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr Palitha Mahipala along with his team Incident Manager, Dr Michael Lukwiya and EPI team lead Dr Osama Mere attended a virtual meeting with Asian Development Bank (ADB), at WHO country office, Islamabad. Participants from ADB included Mr Hiddo Huitzing and Mr Omer Bin Zia.

The meeting discussed the Asia Pacific Vaccine Access Facility (APVAX) loans, Pakistan National Deployment and Vaccination Plan (NDVP), and current response to COVID-19. ADB is working closely with other development partners in Pakistan, and they contacted WHO and UNICEF for a specific advisory role.

During his closing remark, Dr Palitha Mahipala informed ADB that WHO is supporting the Government of Pakistan technically and financially to respond to COVID-19 and appreciated the support ADB is rendering to Pakistan Government to respond to COVID-19.
