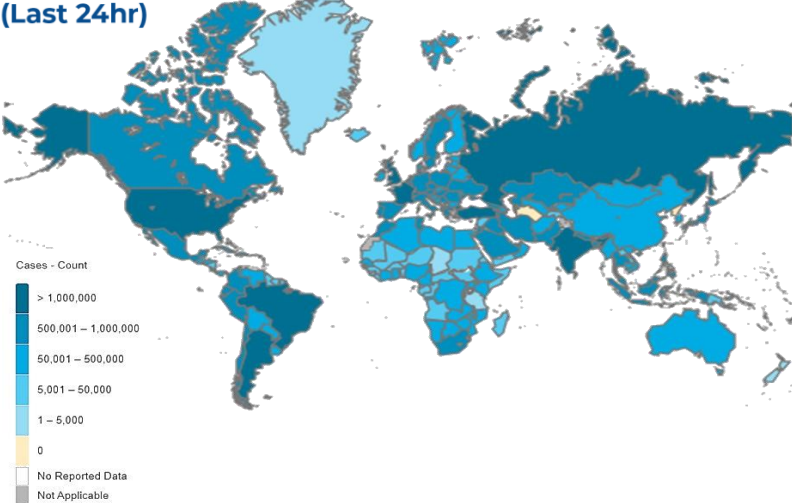

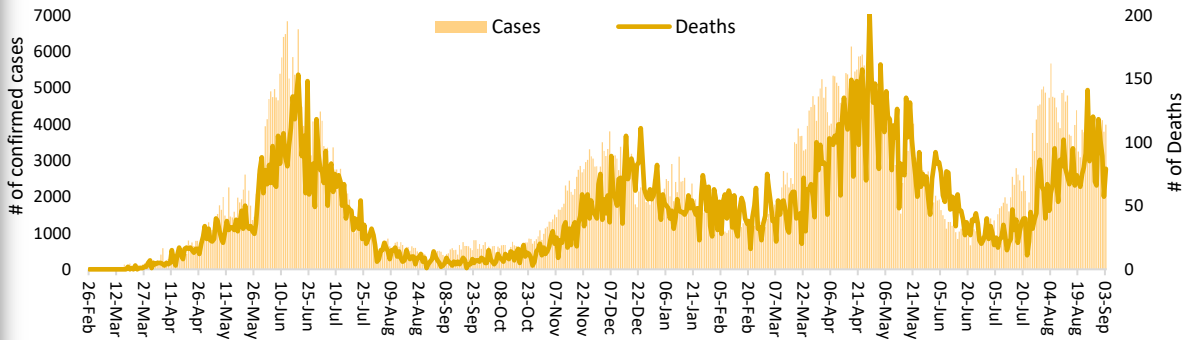

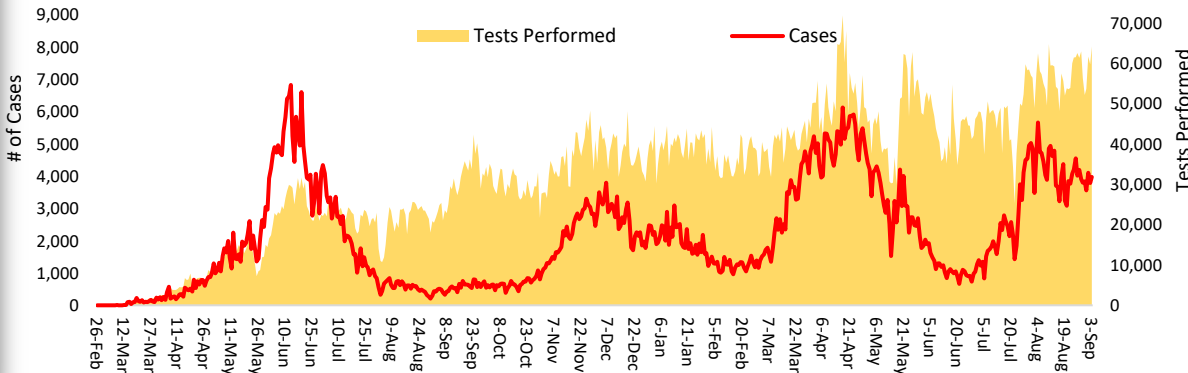

On 2nd September 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan, Dr Palitha Mahipala paid a visit to the Hon. Provincial Health Minister Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP) Mr. Taimor Saleem jhagra at Minister's house KPK. The WR was accompanied by the head of WHO sub office KP, Dr Babar Alam and WHO/NPO Vector borne diseases, Dr Qutbuddin Kakar. The Director General Health Services KP, Dr Niaz Muhammad attended the meeting. The objective of the meeting was to discuss the COVID-19 response and provision of other essential health services.

During the discussions, the WR agreed to extend WHO support for establishment of a communication unit for enhance vaccine uptake. He later donated glucantime injections for management of leishmaniasis. The donation was received by the health minister, who appreciated WHO support.
