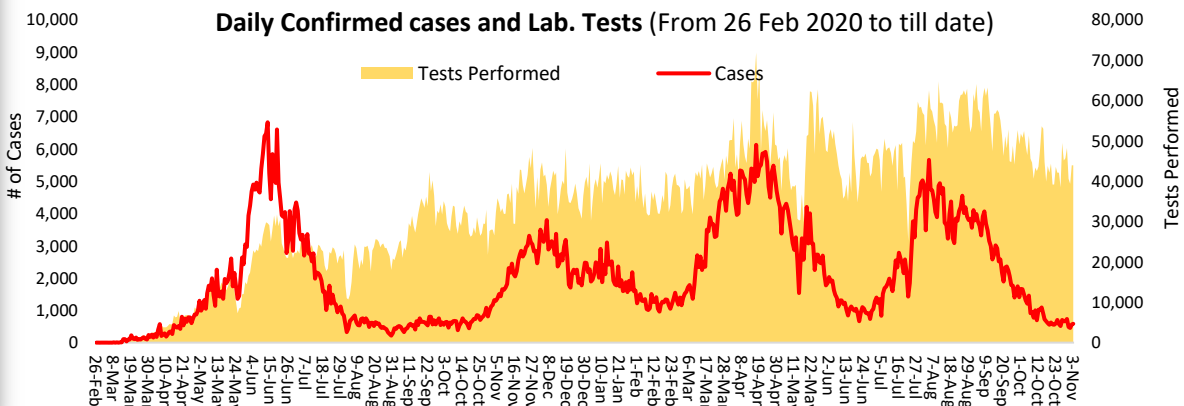

On 3rd November 2021, WHO Country Representative Pakistan Dr. Palitha Mahipala paid a courtesy call to Chairman National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) Lieutenant General Akhtar Nawaz at NDMA Office, Prime Minister Secretariate Islamabad. During the visit, Dr Palitha appreciated the government of Pakistan response to the COVID-19 Pandemic and earthquake in Harani. He highlighted WHO Support to the Government of Pakistan during the COVID-19 Pandemic and the earthquake. Dr Palitha also handed over an assortment of medicines and pledged to provide additional 2,000 blankets to support the earthquake affected people of Harani. The emergency medicine will support care for 63,000 affected population for the next 3 months. The Chairman NDMA appreciated the role of WHO and thanked Dr Palitha Mahipala for the support provided during the COVID-19 pandemic and the Balochistan earthquake.
